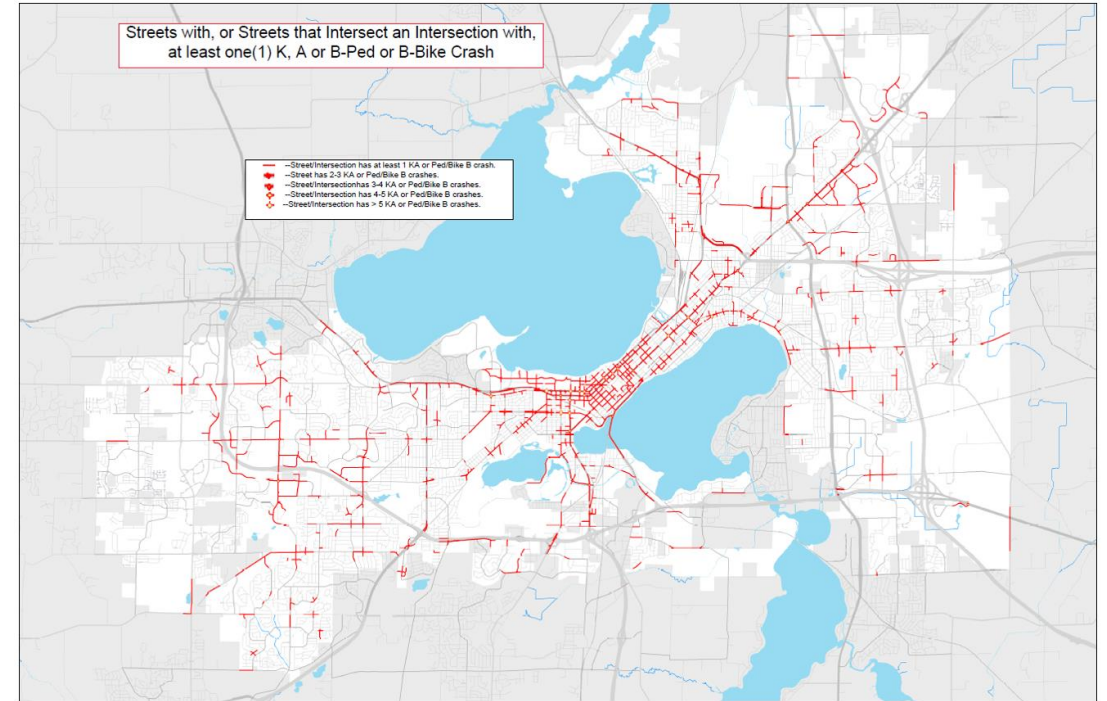
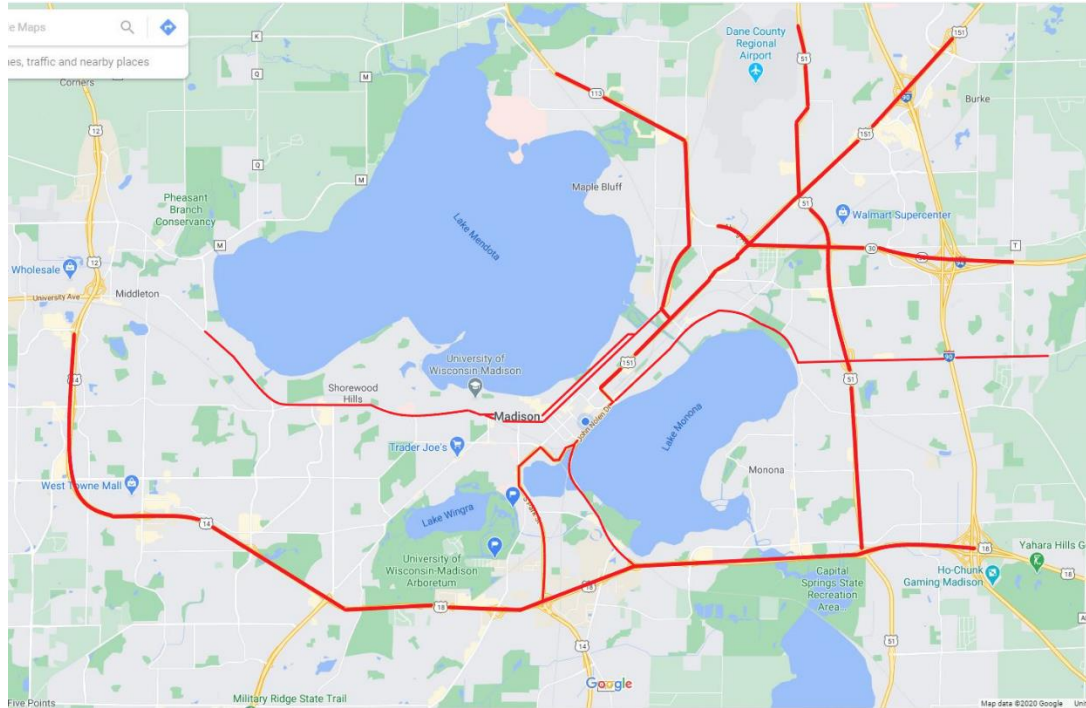


2021 Traffic Enforcement Goals

4. Responsive to citizen complaints

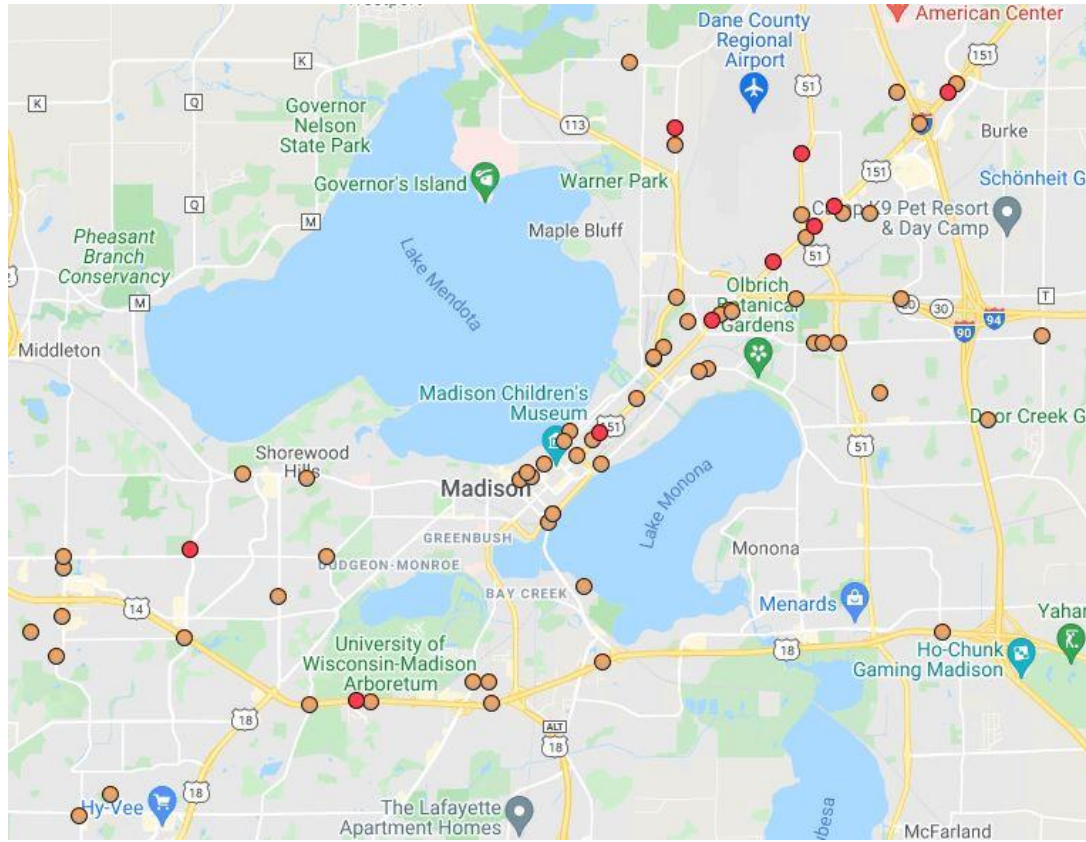


Traffic Grant Corridors / Temp HIN (DRAFT)

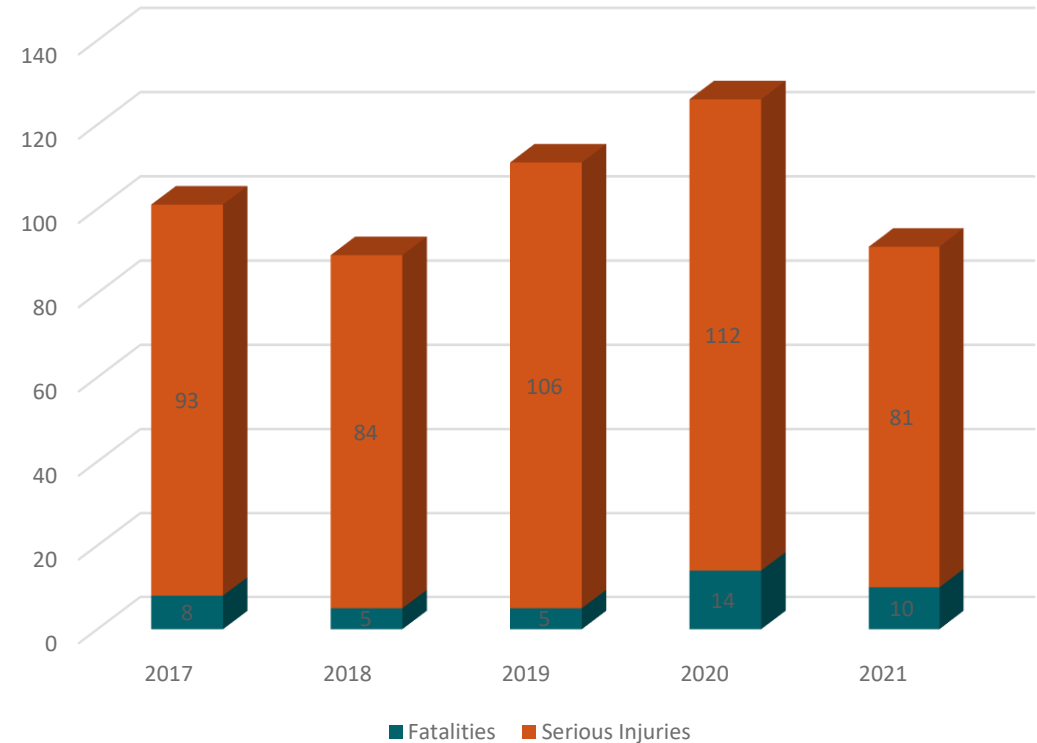




2021 YTD Fatal & Serious Crash Locations



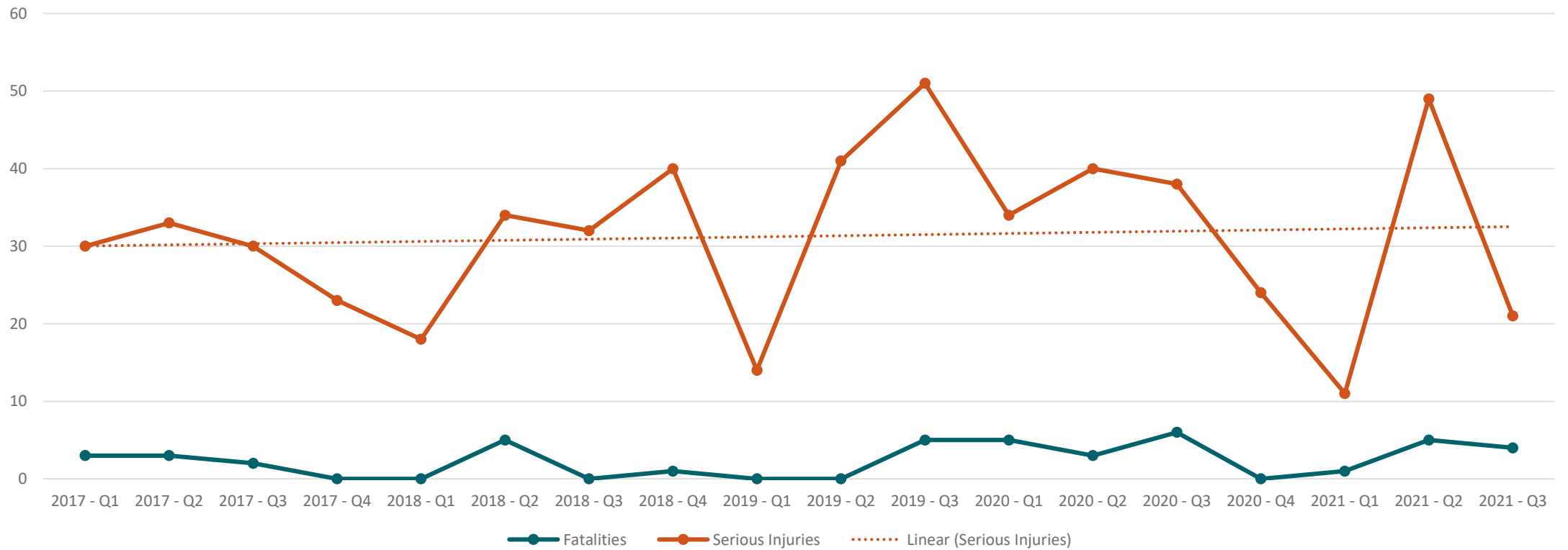

Serious and Fatal Crashes

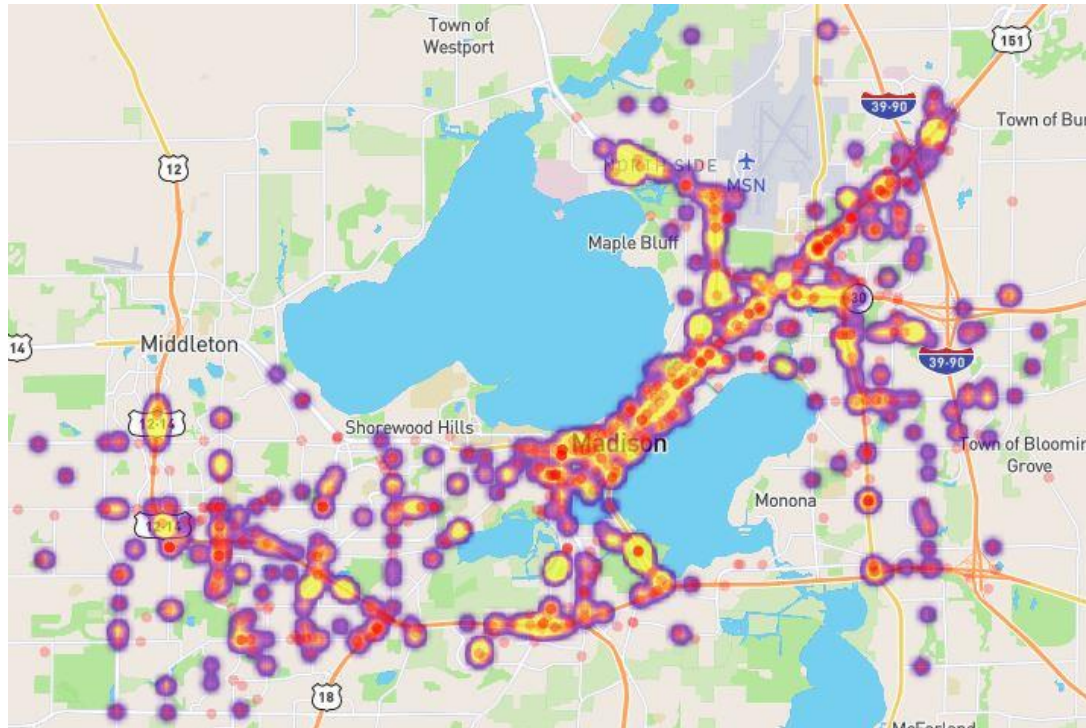
Injuries & Fatalities
by Quarter



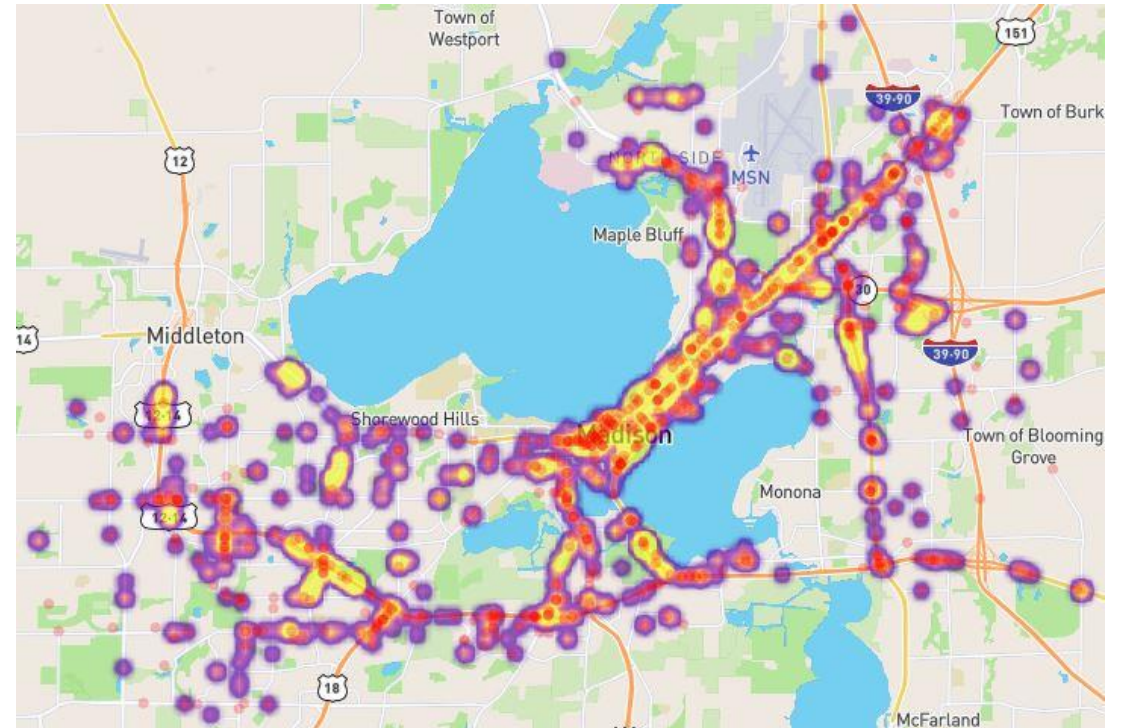

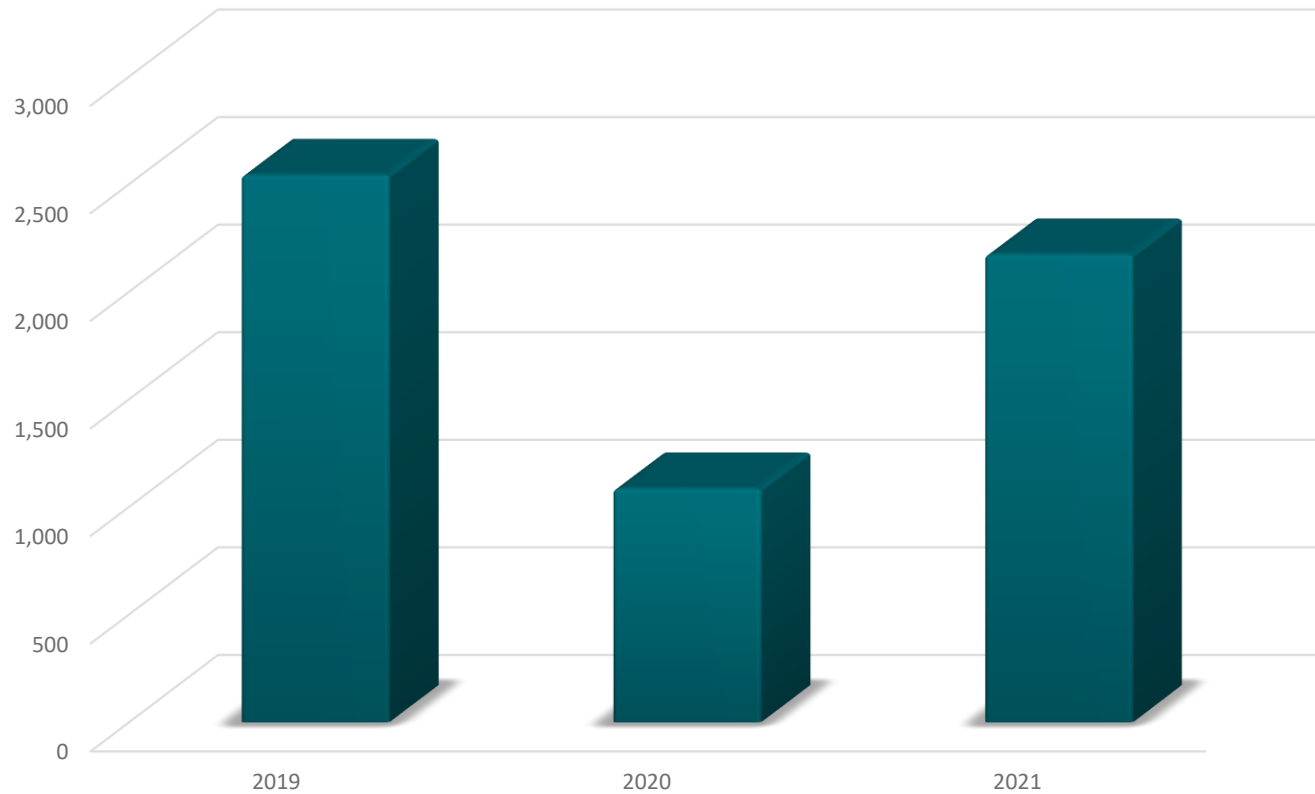

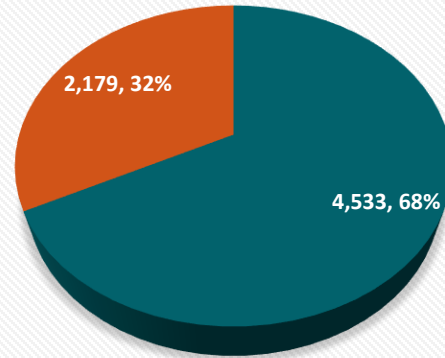

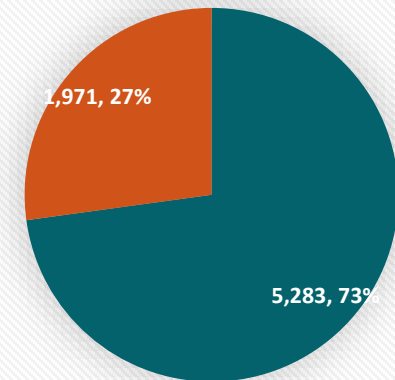

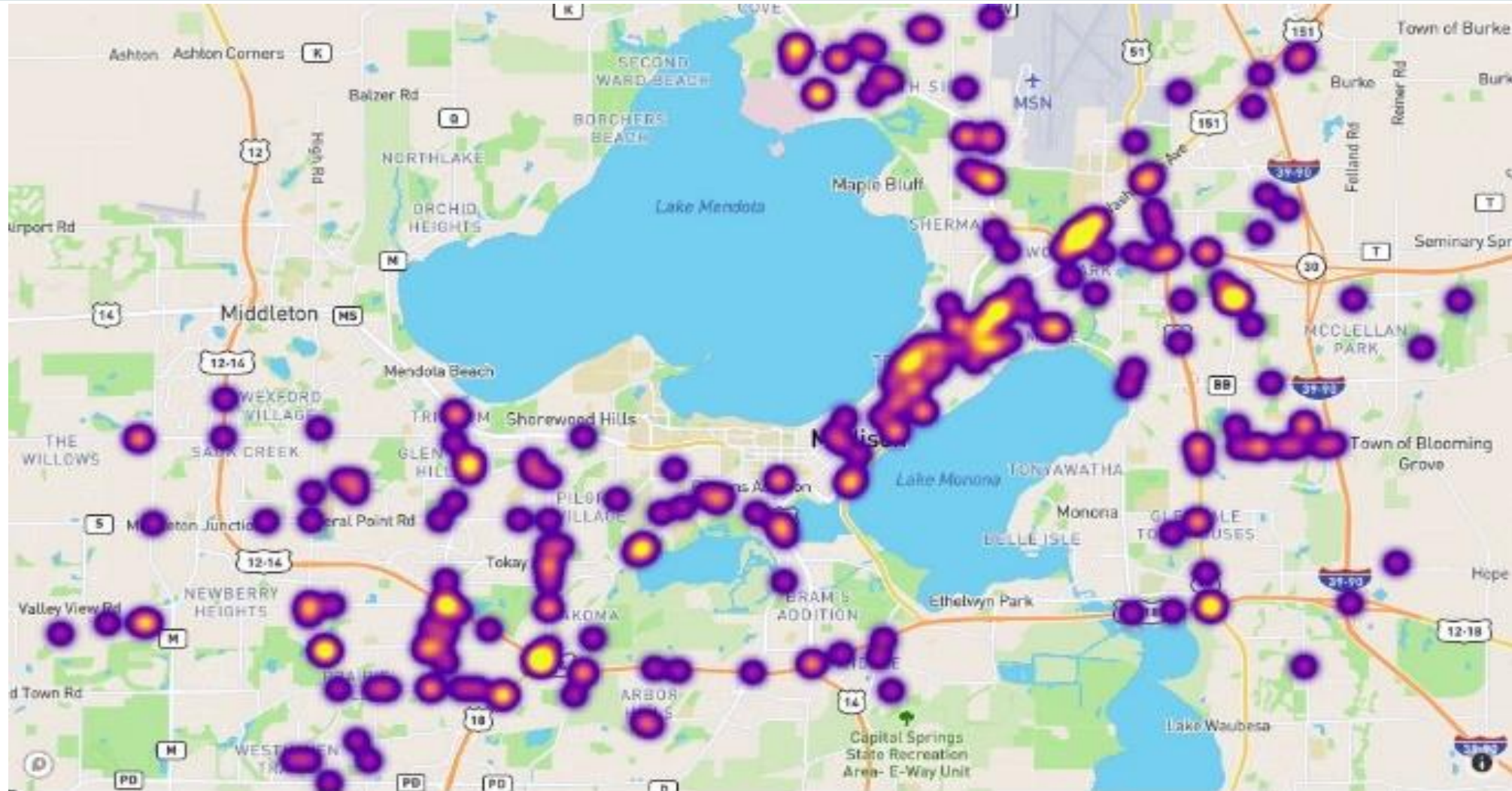
