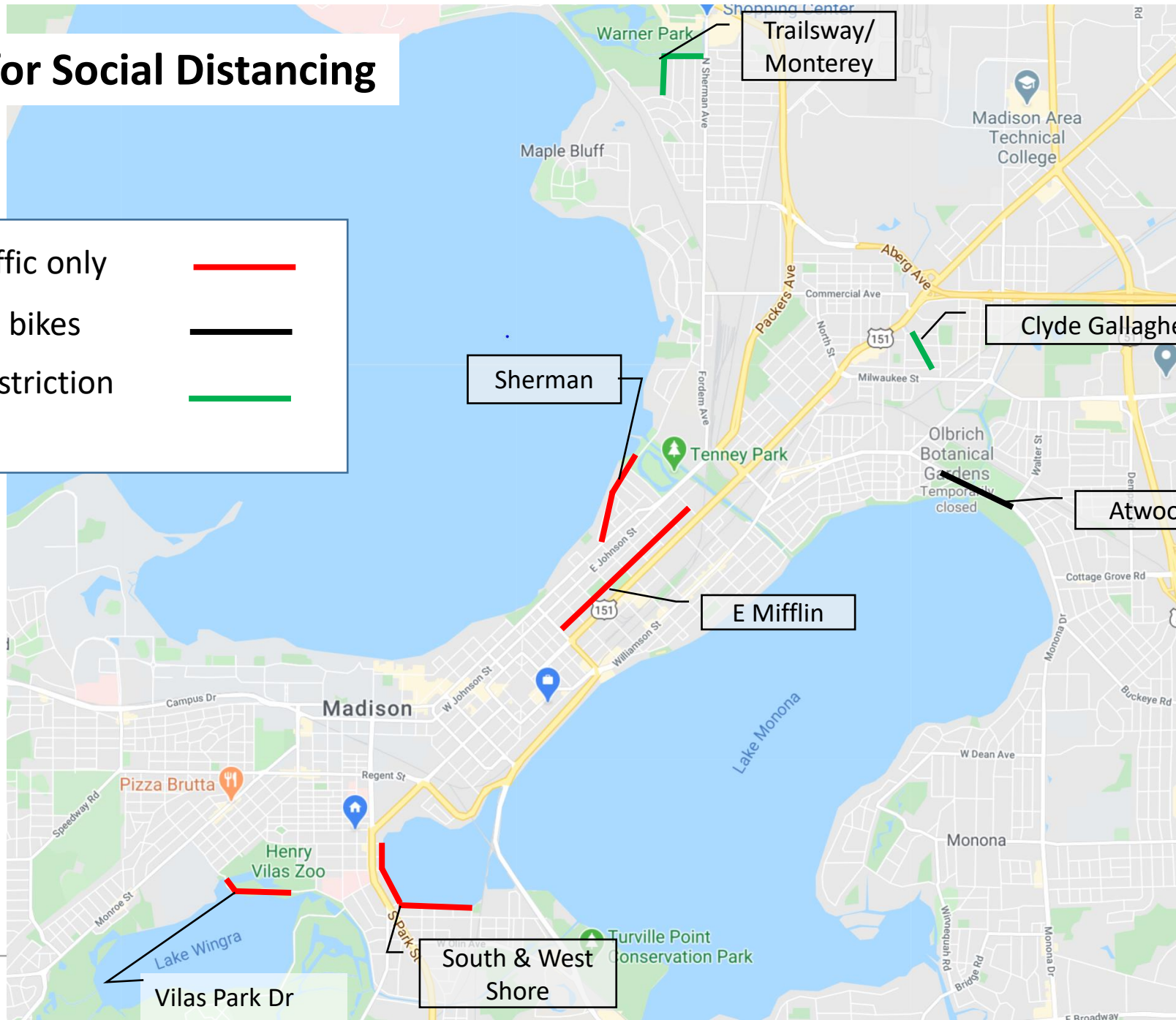


2020 Shared Streets for Social Distancing

Madison Shared Streets Survey

In April, the City of Madison launch a Shared Street program, implementing “soft closures” on some local streets, closing one park drive, repurposing a travel lane in one location to create space for biking and widening the shoulder of the Capital City Path from Monona Terrace to Machinery Row. The goal was to assist community members in having safe, healthy spaces for walking and biking during covid-19. The street closures and lane changes will be coming out for the winter. This survey is part of an evaluation of the Shared Streets program that will assist in determining if this program should continue and what, if any, changes should be made to the program.
