NEW BUSINESS

- 1. DISCUSSION ITEM: Review draft of language for University Ave. Vending Area. Consider effect of Exclusive Use status for any events which occur within that perimeter. Also look at revised map.**

2. **DISCUSSION ITEM: Establish Regent-Monroe Street Vending Area to be used by vendors with basic Street Vendor License. Designate and mark specific sites for use on University of Wisconsin home football game days. Establish maximum number of appropriate vending sites, with waiting list. Establish site assignment system, probably based on seniority and traditional sites vendors have been consistently using over the years. Create map of area.**
3. **DISCUSSION ITEM: Planning for the future. Avoiding a street vending version of urban sprawl. Establishing maximum numbers in some or all street vending categories, with waiting lists.**
4. **DISCUSSION ITEM: Make consistent the seniority process for vending categories that have them.**
5. **DISCUSSION ITEM: Consider requiring background checks for street vendor applicants, what criteria would justify it, and who would pay for it.**
