

Proposed Fare Increase – Alternate Proposal (M2)

Highlights

- Low Income Pass proposed to increase \$0.50 (1.8%)
- EZ Rider (School Year) pass only increased 5.0% - Provides discount for purchasing 2 semesters at once.
- Summer Youth Pass proposed to increase 16.7%.
- DayTripper Pass proposed to increase 23.8%
- Unlimited Ride Pass Rate proposed to increase 17.4%
