Dear Ms. Kovich,

I am writing with a heavy heart as a colleague of Margot Rosen and as someone who works closely with her at the Human Rights Campaign.

Last week, Margot's nephew, Sasha Rosen, was struck and killed by an SUV while crossing Park Street to catch the bus to school. He was seventeen years old. He did everything right. He was a high school senior with a full life ahead of him, deeply loved by his family and community. His death was not an accident. It was preventable.

I have already submitted a formal request for additional street lighting and increased patrols in the area, but I am writing to urge immediate and visible action beyond paperwork. Park Street is a known danger corridor. Speeding, inadequate signal timing, and insufficient pedestrian protections continue to put lives at risk.

No family should have to bury a child because known safety issues were left unaddressed.

I am asking you, as a leader with the power to act, to prioritize concrete interventions now. This includes traffic signal improvements, speed enforcement, pedestrian safety infrastructure, and any emergency measures that can be implemented without delay.

Please let Sasha's life be a turning point, not another name added to a list. I would welcome the opportunity to discuss what immediate steps your office can take.

Thank you for your time and for your leadership in this moment.
