

Board of Health for Madison and Dane County
Tuberculosis Clinical Services
Resolution #2007-14

With the merger, the contract between the Wisconsin Division of Public Health, Bureau of Communicable Diseases and Preparedness and the Dane County Division of Public Health for the provision of TB dispensary services moves to the merged agency. Under this agreement, the State provides the Department with funds to reimburse local physicians for TB services that are not paid through other health coverage. These services include medical evaluation, chest x-ray and obtaining specimens for lab testing. Also included are services provided by Public Health, including tuberculin skin testing, medication for treatment of tuberculosis disease and infection, directly observed therapy, investigation, case management and other related services. Reimbursement is at the medical assistance rate. The purpose of this agreement is to ensure care for uninsured high-risk persons.

This resolution authorizes the Director to execute an agreement with the Wisconsin Division of Public Health.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County authorizes the Director to sign an agreement with the Wisconsin Division of Public Health, Bureau of Communicable Diseases and Preparedness for tuberculosis dispensary services for the period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.
