**RESOLUTION REQUIRING THAT THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
AUTHORITY COMPLY WITH THE CITY OF MADISON'S LIVING WAGE
ORDINANCE**

PREAMBLE

In 1999, the Common Council adopted Section 4.20, Madison General Ordinances, entitled Living Wage. This ordinance requires that certain persons be paid a minimum wage when performing work for the City. The ordinance is applicable to five categories of workers: City employees, including hourly employees; employees performing work under a City service contract in an amount greater than \$5000; employees performing work for a recipient of City financial assistance in an amount greater than \$100,000; employees of a recipient of City financial assistance greater than \$100,000 who work on a project site funded by such assistance; and employees of a contractor of the recipient of City financial assistance who work at least twenty hours a week at the project site funded by such assistance. In 2008, the living wage required to be paid under the ordinance is \$10.92 an hour.

Now therefore, be it resolved, that the Community Development Authority of the City of Madison shall comply with the City of Madison's Living Wage Ordinance.
