



# Shots Fired


- There were 35 shots fired incidents in the City from October 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup> (2025). Year-to-date we received 117 reports of shots fired.
- Through Q4 we saw a **24.2% decrease** in shots fired incidents compared to the 3-year average (154).





# Opiate/Opioid Overdoses and Deaths


- Opiate/Opioid Overdoses – MPD responded to 47 known opiate/opioid overdoses during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2025. Year-to-date there were 187 known opiate/opioid overdoses. Through Q4 we saw a **16.5% decrease** in known opiate/opioid overdoses compared to the 3-year average (259).
- There were 4 suspected opiate/opioid overdose deaths during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2025. Year-to-date there were 19 suspected opiate/opioid overdose deaths.





# Robberies


- There were 36 robberies reported in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2025. Year-to-date 106 robberies were reported.
- Through Q4 we saw a **14.5% decrease** of robberies reported compared to the 3-year average (124).





# Burglaries


- MPD responded to 85 burglaries during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2025. Year-to-date 406 burglaries were reported.
- Through Q4 we saw a **42.6% decrease** of burglaries reported compared to the 3-year average (707).





# Stolen Autos


- MPD investigated 60 reports of stolen autos during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2025. Year-to-date 284 autos were reported stolen.
- Through Q4 we saw a **50% decrease** of stolen autos reported compared to the 3-year average (568).





# Theft from Autos

- MPD investigated 114 thefts from vehicles during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2025. Year-to-date 570 reports of theft from autos were reported.
- Through Q4 we saw a **19.3% decrease** of thefts from autos reported compared to the 3-year average (706).
