Highlights/Remarks:

Cashiered Revenues: In addition to 2 extra revenue-generating days this year, Coupon revenue is also up about \$24,000 compared to 2007, resulting in the \$55,720 increase over 2007 (Col A) and the \$32,940 increase over Budget (Col C). (The increase for Coupon revenue is simply due to the timing of receipts.)

On-Street Meter Revenues: While there was one extra revenue-generating day for On-Street Meters this year, it appears this was more than offset by the four 'sets' of snow days thru February. As a result, On-Street Meter revenues are running about \$31,300 behind 2007 levels (Col A) and about \$29,000 behind our budget projections (Col C).

Construction-Related Revenues: While construction-related revenues are running about \$5,000 higher compared to 2007 (Col A), our 2008 budget projection was set a bit higher, resulting in a slight decrease compared to budget (Col C). We've noticed that YTD hangtag sales are lower for the first time since inception of the program in April 1998; specifically, thru the end of February 2008, we sold 316 fewer permits (-\$3,560) vs 2007. Construction-related meter removals are also running about \$4,600 behind 2007 levels. However, as Meter Hood revenue is about \$13,140 above 2007 levels, a 'shift' (from hangtags and meter removal to 'hooding') could simply be occurring.

RP3/Miscellaneous Revenues: Thru the end of February 2008, we have sold 60 fewer permits compared to 2007. Advertising revenue is also off, about -\$1,520 thru February. Subsequent to preparation of our Budget, ten display ads were removed from our ramps (per discretion of Adams Outdoor Advertising); thus, total revenues for this line item will come in about \$8,100 **below** budget, assuming no additional changes.

Bottomline: As shown in Col C, our bottom line is pretty much right on target with the Budget, *thru February anyway!*

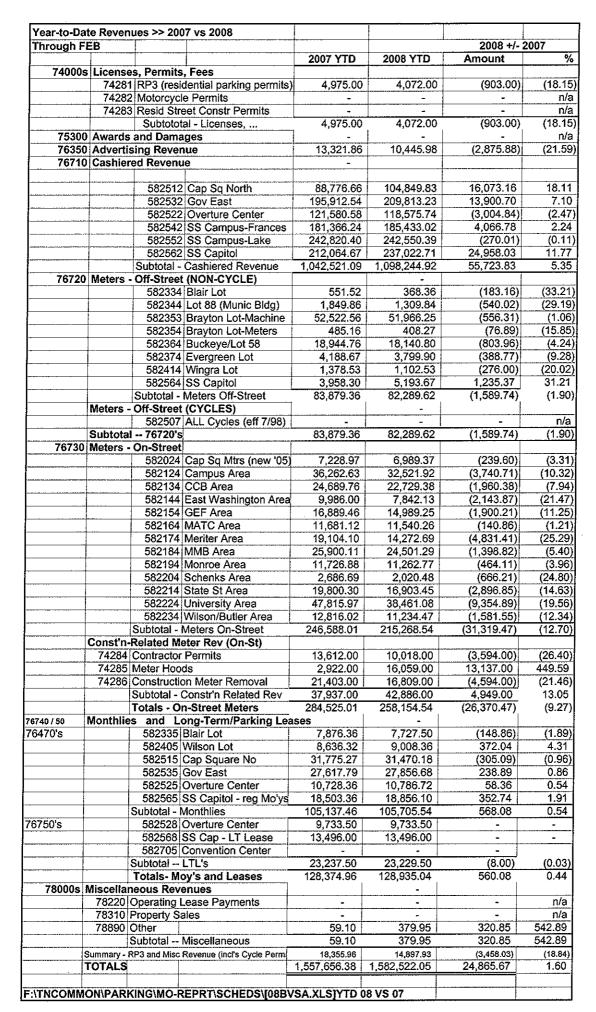
MARCH ACTIVITY REPORT

Staff worked on the following projects during March:

- began work on our 2007 Revenue/Expense Overview report (which will be presented at the May meeting);
- began preparing RFP for multi-space meters
- continued discussions on Brayton/MMB/GE development
- finalized concrete remediation contracts
- began preparation of our in-house revenue/expense statements; and continued efforts with I.T. staff to develop an **online** renewal process for residential parking permits (RP3 permits) we anticipate this online process, which will allow for payment via credit/debit card, will be available for the upcoming renewal season (which begins about mid-July).

Notes:

- 1. "Total Spaces" is the number of spaces generally available for public or monthly parking. It excludes DIS/VET spaces, Authorized Vehicles Only spaces, etc.
- 2. "Spaces in Operation" is the number of spaces available for public or monthly parking, as follows:
- a.On-street meters, all lots and metered sections of ramps on the day vacancy count is made.
- b.Cashier section of ramps -- the daily average computed for the month.
- c.Monthly rental stalls -- the day the vacancy count is made for lots and metered section of ramps.
- 3. Vacancies are determined as follows:
- a.On-street meters, all lots and metered section of ramps -- by counting the vacant spaces one day (Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday) per month between the hours of 11 a.m. and 1 p.m.
- b.Cashier sections of ramps -- using a 95 percent Trimmed Mean calculated from daily records kept at each facility. The least number of vacancies occurring on each weekday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. is used to compute this mean.
- c.Monthly -- from records in Parking Division on the day the count is made for lots and metered section of ramps.
- 4.Note that monthly stalls are not available for daily parking when there are vacancies. Therefore, any calculations regarding the number of vacant spaces available to the general public should ignore these spaces.
- 1 State Street Capitol Ramp Average of 7 spaces out of service for December.
- 2 Capitol Square South Ramp 14 metered spaces out of service due to snow.
- 3 State Street Capitol Ramp Average of 6 spaces out of service for January.
- 4 Capitol Square South Ramp 8 metered spaces out of service due to snow.
- 5 Overture Center Ramp Average of 6 spaces out of service for February.
- 6 State Street Capitol Ramp Average of 9 spaces out of service for February.
- 7 Sate Street Campus Ramp Average of 7 spaces out of service for February.
- 8 Capitol Square South Ramp 29 metered spaces out of service due to snow.
- 9 Capitol Square South Ramp 16 permit spaces out of service due to snow

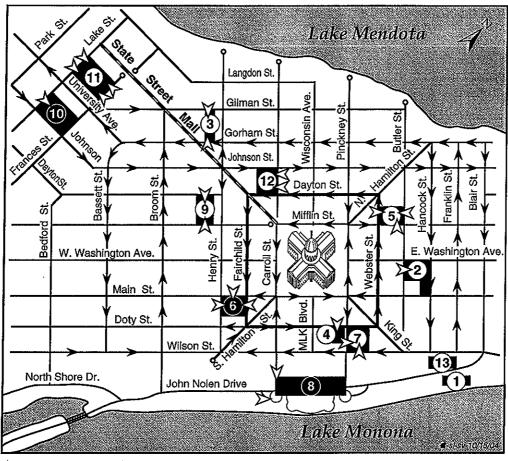
