1. All entertainment license applicants shall submit a security plan at the time of application. The plan shall indicate what type of live entertainment the establishment will offer. The plan shall indicate the number of security personnel the applicant will employ and/or hire through a private security company and how they will be utilized.
 - (a) DJ services
 - (b) Employees
 - a. 1 - Door Person: Will be utilized to check IDs and ensure that capacity is not exceeded

2. The security plan shall set forth how the applicant will handle issues regarding:
 - (a) control and clearance of any parking lot during hours of operation and at closing time; how any entrance line will be managed and controlled;
 - (b) unruly patrons;
 - (c) intoxicated patrons; patrons presenting false IDs;
 - (d) control and supervision of patrons under the age of twenty-one (21);
 - (e) circumstances under which police should be called and how physical disturbances, including fights, will be handled and
 - (f) how applicant will maintain the orderly appearance and operation of the premises with respect to litter and noise.
 - (a) Our landlord, Madison Property Management, utilizes the services of JBM patrol to insure the security of the Constellation building as well as the corresponding parking lot. In addition, our management and security team will be responsible for additional perimeter walks to help maintain security.
 - (b) Unruly patrons will be asked to leave from the restaurant. Failure to comply will be grounds for escorted eviction. Further difficulties will result in police contact.
 - (c) Intoxicated persons will not be provided with alcoholic beverages. They will be monitored and offered transportation services.
 - (d) Only patrons 21 and older will be allowed access for our late-night services, which will be the only time that entertainment is provided.
 - (e) Police will be contacted in cases where patrons refuse to comply with directives set out by service personnel. Although our staff will look to intervene in altercations where they are able to do so safely, police will be notified of any and all situations where verbal or physical abuse is made evident.
 - (f) Employees of Sujeo will be responsible for the maintenance of areas surrounding the restaurant insofar as it relates to litter and noise. Protocols for service loops will be put into place to insure cleanliness and order.
