Our venue is quite small and to fit in with the neighborhood requests I book small bands, acoustic duos, classical guitarists and use an Ipod with a small Bose speaker as well as computer generated music from playlists. None of them have large amplifiers.

Security issues have not been a problem for us. In the event that there is my staff follows these procedures. First everyone must be of legal age. Second should a disturbance arise try to get the person to an out of way space and calm the situation down. Do not serve the person anymore. If the person continues to cause a problem try to find a responsible party to get them home. If this is not a recourse call a cab for them or if the situation escalates call the police.

We have never had any situations of this nature. One outspoken wedding guest, but family dealt with him.

When there is entertainment scheduled I have extra staff. We typically have 20-45 people that come for the music. There are three food/bar servers and one floor person to monitor the crowd.
