PUBLIC NOTICE

CenturyTel Acquisition, LLC a (CenturyLink company) will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison in the summer of 2012. This work is being done in order to provide data delivery services to a customer in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, June 20th, 2012 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Cable installation contractors hired by CenturyTel Acquisition, LLC / LightCore will install buried fiber optic cable within the right-of-way limits, via directional boring and trenching at the following location:

South Route: S. Stoughton Rd. (Service Rd. East) at 2217 S Stoughton Rd, to the intersection of Pflaum Rd. & Highway 51 continuing along Pflaum Rd.

North Route: Starting at 4417 Helgesen Dr. going east to S. Stoughton Rd. (Service Rd. East) continuing to Allis Ave. From the intersection of Allis Ave & S. Stoughton Rd. (Service Rd. West) heading east to Shaffer Ave.

Restoration within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5" lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
