Passed - No Action - Repealing Section 9.13(6)(j)2.b., and amending Section 9.13(6)(j) 3. of the Madison General Ordinances to temporarily repeal the requirement that restaurant wait staff must carry and serve all food, beverage and alcohol beverages to patrons within a sidewalk cafe, and to allow patrons of all types of sidewalk cafes to carry out their own food, beverage and alcohol beverages from the restaurant to the sidewalk cafe, and to make the temporary repeal effective from April 15, 2006 to December 31, 2006.
