2. <u>12418</u> Facilitating the Voting Process for Non-Felons in Dane County Jail.

Adam Gallagher of the City Clerk's Office reported that the Sheriff's Department is still gathering data, but has indicated that the Dane County Jail has more inmates in the summer than in the winter.

		Williams said one solution would be for the state to pass legislation that would allow eligible voters who are suddenly in jail on election day to appoint an agent like voters who are hospitalized or part of a sequestered jury.
		Better asked Williams to put her suggestions on paper before the next MEAC meeting.
