The Common Council Organizational Committee (CCOC) will review all resumes and interview applicants at a special meeting to be held on Wednesday, September 10, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. in Room 103A, City-County Building. The CCOC will make a recommendation to the Common Council to be acted upon at their September 16, 2008 meeting. The person appointed by the Common Council would then serve until a 7<sup>th</sup> district alderperson is elected on April 7, 2009 and takes the official oath of office.
