825 Jupiter Drive & 5801 Gemini Drive - Amended PUD (GDP-SIP)
Redesign of Previously approved Residential Development. 3rd Ald. Dist.

The motion required modifications to the 29-unit's east elevation to project asymmetrically up to the parapet that portion of the building adjunct to the lion's canopied entry. In addition, the landscape plan should be modified to remove the use of autumn purple ash with a more appropriate wide canopy tree due to issues with por infestation.

A motion was made by Barnett, seconded by Rummel, to Grant Final Approval. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

3. 11814 3210 Maple Grove Drive - Mixed-Use Development/PUD-GDP. 7th Ald. Dist.

The motion on final approval on the GDP as proposed with the following:

- The address of pedestrian connectivity between the various development components of the overall GDP must be addressed at the SIP level to provide for provisions for connectivity of lands to the west.
- Look at alternative locations to flip surface parking to be immediately adjacent to the south side of the independent living facility.
- Provide walkways around the stormwater and bioretention areas including an aesthetically appealing design that goes beyond its functional use.
- Provide opportunities for the banking of parking with the various components of the project.
- Provide tree islands at 12 to 15 stall ratio.

Those voting in opposition noted the project's failure to comply with the provisions of the City of Madison Comprehensive Plan relevant to providing for mixed-use development as noted within the provisions for Neighborhood

Mixed-Use (NMU) where the project provides for individual segregated uses in separate buildings on the site as well as the failure to provide for the requirement in support of 2-4 stories development within both the provisions for the Neighborhood Mixed District as well as Transit-Oriented Development.
