Attached is an initial phase of improvements (for John Nolen, Blair and Wilson), which we might be able to construct yet this year. Please note that a significant part of these improvements is the pavement marking, which is more weather dependent than the concrete or asphalt. Let me know as soon as possible, if this project is to be constructed this fall, so I can see if our epoxy marking contractor will be able to do the markings.

2006 TEMPORARY IMPROVEMENTS (by corner number)

- (1.) Bike Crossing (BC) on South Blair St.
- (2.) Pull back planter curb about 3' with new curbing.
Bike Box (BB), stop bar and remarked cross walk on Wilson St.
- (3.) No Work at this time.
- (4.) Curb modification to facilitate bike RR crossing. Also reconstructed landing and ramps at a new enhanced pedestrian crossing and stop bar marked on pavement.

COMMENTS ON IMPROVEMENTS

General: This design was prepared using air photo data only. Verify all dimensions, locations and clearances with a survey prior to construction. All pavement marking is dependent on weather and temperature.

Corner Specific:

- (1.) Modifications to this corner are likely to involve traffic signals and will require a Council resolution approving the plans and specs.
- (2.) Obtain neighborhood approval for the planter modification. The suggested modification is intended to not disturb existing plantings.
- (4.) The curb modification is intended to not affect utilities, traffic signals or street lights. Verify with current survey data. Also verify that the RR gate does not infringe on the proposed crosswalk when in the down position.

No curb modifications at this corner unless coordinated with traffic signal modifications and plans & specifications are approved by a Common Council resolution.
