While patrolling the area I discovered this Dodge Ram pickup parked on the street at parking meter number 3964. This is in front of 409 N. Frances St. Its registration was under suspension for unpaid parking citations of \$370.00 and had expired on 11/30/2005. No pending court dates were set. I confirmed this info through WI. DMV and the Dane County Data Operator. Parking Supervisor, (Sgt. Strassman) and Parking Leadworker, (Stefanie Neisen) had previously instructed all parking enforcement officers, (P.E.O.'s) to cite and impound this vehicle if we found it parked on a city street. Madison Police Department's parking scofflaw policy requires impounding of any vehicle found illegally parked with \$250.00 or more of unpaid citations and no court dates on record. It was illegally parked because it was unregistered on the street. Sgt. Strassman also instructed P.E.O.'s to have a police officer backup when dealing with this truck or its owner, Mr. Okafu.

<p>He has been confrontational, verbally abusive and physically threatening with P.E.O.'s in the past. I called for backup and Officer Chaney responded. Mr. Okafu was not on the scene at this time. I got a case number, called for Schmidt's towing to respond and issued the unregistered vehicle on the street citation. Schmidt's arrived and loaded the Dodge onto the flatbed. The tow truck driver, Officer Chaney and I were standing next to his squad car when Mr. Okafu walked right up to me. His chest touched mine, his face no more than a couple inches away. He angrily asked me "What the fuck do you think you are doing?". I put both of my hands up in front of me to defend myself and asked him to "back up a few feet". He did not move. I was greatly disturbed and fearful that he would cause me physical harm. Mr. Okafu is about six feet three inches tall, and a muscular 250-300 pounds. I am only five foot, eight inches tall and much smaller. He was aggressive and potentially violent. Officer Chaney stepped over and loudly ordered Mr. Okafu to back away from me. The officer had to put his hand on Mr. Okafu's chest and push him back before he would move. I also quickly took several steps backward while also urging the tow truck driver to back up. Mr. Okafu squared off with Officer Chaney now and began to shout at him. Mr. Okafu stood defiantly with both arms tensed and held slightly out from his sides.</p>					

OFFICER CHANEY STATED LOUDLY " I AM A POLICE OFFICER , back up ". MR OKAFO REFUSED TO MOVE AND STATED " IT'S A GOOD THING YOU ARE HERE CAUSE I WAS JUST GOING TO FUCK HIM UP ". HE LOOKED OVER AT ME AS HE SAID THIS . OFFICER CHANEY THEN TOLD MR. OKAFO TO " BACK UP AND PUT YOUR HANDS BEHIND YOUR BACK ". MR. OKAFO JUST STOOD IN PLACE DEFIANTLY , TENSED UP AND LOOKING LIKE HE WOULD SWING AT THE OFFICER IF HE TRIED TO HANDCUFF HIM . MR OKAFO STATED " YOU BETTER GET LOTS OF HELP IF YOU WANT TO TRY AND FIGHT ME ! ". OFFICER CHANEY CALLED FOR BACKUP AND DEPLOYED HIS TAZER . HE WARNED MR. OKAFO SIX OR SEVEN TIMES TO PUT HIS HANDS BEHIND HIS BACK OR HE WOULD TAZE HIM . MR OKAFO DID NOT COMPLY BUT CONTINUED TO CHALLENGE THE OFFICER . OFFICER CHANEY FIRED THE TAZER WHICH APPEARED TO STRIKE MR. OKAFO IN THE CHEST . MR. OKAFO SEEMED COMPLETELY UNAFFECTED AND HE PULLED THE DARTS

I GOT INTO THE PARKING ENFORCEMENT SQUAD FOR MY PROTECTION AND CALLED DISPATCH TO ADVISE THEM THAT THE OFFICER WAS NOW IN A PHYSICAL FIGHT AND NEEDED HELP RIGHT AWAY . I GOT BACK OUT OF MY VEHICLE TO ASSIST OFFICER CHANEY IF NEEDED . THEY WERE BOTH STILL GRAPPLING WITH EACH OTHER . OFFICER CHANEY HAD MR OKAFO UP AGAINST THE SIDE OF HIS SQUAD AND WAS ATTEMPTING TO GET CONTROL OF HIS ARMS AND LEGS TO HANDCUFF HIM . MR. OKAFO CONTINUED TO FIGHT AND BROKE FREE OF THE OFFICER . HE RAN ACROSS THE STREET TOWARDS THE CITY PARKING RAMP . AT THE SIDEWALK OFFICER CHANEY WAS ABLE TO TACKLE MR. OKAFO AND HOLD HIM DOWN UNTILL MORE OFFICERS ARRIVED . HE WAS PLACED IN HANDCUFFS AND IN OFFICER CHANEY'S SQUAD . I AM CERTAIN THAT HAD OFFICER CHANEY NOT BEEN THERE TO PROTECT ME THAT I WOULD HAVE BEEN ATTACKED BY MR. OKAFO AND POSSIBLY INJURED . I AM VERY GRATEFUL FOR HIS ASSISTANCE . AFTER TAKING OUR STATEMENTS , SCHMIDT TOWED MR. OKAFO'S TRUCK TO IMPOUND DUE TO THE AMOUNT OF UNPAID CITATIONS DUE TO THE CITY OF MADISON .
