RESOLUTION

Background: The CDA was awarded funding under the Resident Opportunity for Self Sufficiency (ROSS) program. This program is to provide funding for case management services to assist Low Rent Public Housing residents in employment related services to help them improve their financial status and no longer need government assistance. This proposed contract will pay for the services of a case manager and trainer provided by the Urban League. This contract period will be for one year from the date of the agreed upon start date of this contract. The contract amount for this period will be \$62,000.00. (sixty two thousand and 00/00 dollars)

WHEREAS, the Community Development Authority has received funds under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Resident Opportunities for Self Sufficiency (ROSS) Service Coordinators Family grant program; and

WHEREAS, the Service Coordination will directly provide employment related case management services and establish linkages with other employment related agencies and service providers in the community to provide services to its public housing family residents living in CDA's public housing

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the Executive Director or designee, to sign a one year contract, with the option for two (2) one year extensions.
