2011 Taste of Madison Recycling plan

Taste of Madison will utilize receptacles from Budweiser and Pepsi for recycling during the event, September 3-4, 2011. Receptacles will be placed on all four sides of Capitol Square down the center of each street along with regular trash cans. Taste of Madison volunteers will be responsible to change out the bags as they fill and carry full bags to recycling dumpsters set around Capitol Square.
