Jim - Thanks for the good information.

If all existing conditions on the liquor license and entertainment license will stay in place as verbally agreed to by the applicant, I support the dba name change, change in officers, and the change of agent application for Luchador at 558 State Street. The applicant did hold an informational meeting on the earlier application for a new license that I attended.

Since the applicant is assuming an existing license and conditions, I hesitantly support keeping the hours that Roast had, i.e., staying open until bar time since the conditions of the license are not necessarily under review for these change items. I told the applicant that at license renewal time I would consider recommending a reduction in those hours if MPD, the neighbors, or I felt that any burden was being placed on MPD or the nearby area by the restaurant staying open until bar time.

The applicant expressed a desire to have food delivery service functioning (GrubHub, etc.) until bar time, hence the delivery drivers could be allowed into the establishment after the 1:30am no entry deadline. I don't see a problem with that request, although I leave it to the discretion of ALRC and MPD as to whether or not there are unforeseen consequences to permitting those services to be offered that late.
