



New Route 89: Parking Ramp Shuttle Service - Save up to 36% with New Downtown Parking Options Starts January 2 and Operates until June 15, 2007

The City of Madison Parking Utility and Metro Transit will start a five-month pilot program offering a Parking Ramp Shuttle Service. This service will allow customers to park in less expensive ramps and take the shuttle to their destinations around the square, State Street or the UW Campus.

- The Parking Ramp Shuttle Service will be free for City of Madison parking ramp and Brayton Lot customers with a valid ticket or permit. Additional vehicle passengers can ride on the same ticket/permit.
- All Metro Transit passes and prepaid fares will be accepted.
- Metro's regular fare structure will apply to those who board without a parking entrance ticket and/or prepaid Metro fare.
- Parking Ramp Shuttle Service travels two different routes depending on the time of day.

#### Ways to save:

**Downtown workers:** Ramp "Full" light on where you normally park? No problem! Just drive to the next closest ramp on **Route 89** knowing that the free, convenient **Parking Ramp Shuttle Service** can get you to your destination! If you usually park at the Government East Ramp (\$1.10/hour) you can park at the Capitol Square North Ramp (\$.80/hour) and take the **Parking Ramp Shuttle Service** at a savings of almost \$60 per month — that's 25%!!

Students can also benefit. Park in the Overture Center Ramp for just \$.70/hour (rather than \$1.10/hour at the State Street Campus Ramp), show the driver your ramp entrance ticket as you hop on the next Route 89 Shuttle and save \$.40 per hour -- that's 36%!!

**Visitors:** Want to hit State Street for a few hours of shopping, lunch with friends and a visit to the library or a museum? With the **Weekday Midday-Campus Ramps route** serving all of State Street, you never have to worry about finding a parking space.

#### **SCHEDULE**

Route 89 Parking Ramp Shuttle Service
Operates Monday - Friday from January 2 to June 15, 2007
Travels two different routes depending on the time of day:

Weekday Peak-Capitol Ramps (6:30 AM-8:30 AM and 3:30 PM-5:30 PM)

During peak hours the shuttle will operate along the Capitol Loop every 7-8 minutes, serving the Brayton Lot, Capitol Square North, Government East and State Street Capitol Ramps and taking riders to destinations on the Square as well as city, county and state office buildings.

Weekday Midday-Campus Ramps (8:45 AM-3:15 PM)

The midday shuttle will operate **every 10 minutes**, connecting the University to downtown, and serving the State St. Campus and Overture Center Ramps.
