Permanent Stand Alone Restrooms Portland Loo

- Advantages
 - Does not require attendant
 - Low maintenance
 - Design deters unwanted activities
- Disadvantages
 - Requires modifications for Wisconsin climate
 - Not heated
 - No sink in standard design

Permanent Stand Alone Restrooms Victoria, BC Men's Urinal

- Advantages
 - Does not require attendant
 - Low maintenance
 - Design deters unwanted activities
 - Successful aesthetics
- Disadvantages
 - Requires modifications for Wisconsin climate
 - No roof
 - Men only, expensive to design option for women's use
 - Not heated
 - Requires utility infrastructure

Permanent Stand Alone Restrooms Self Cleaning Public Toilet

- Advantages
 - May not require attendant
 - Design deters unwanted activities by automatically opening after certain period of time
 - Can be heated
 - Reduces some maintenance costs
- Disadvantages
 - Expensive
 - Requires modifications for Wisconsin climate
 - May require user fee
 - Restroom self cleaning feature has limited capabilities
 - Completely enclosed structure no visual access to deter crime
 - Requires utility infrastructure

- Advantages
 - Does not require attendant
 - Low installation and maintenance cost
 - Portable
 - Economical
 - Potential for a trial period
- Disadvantages
 - Negative perception
 - Poor aesthetics
 - Not heated
 - Safety and vandalism concerns
 - No sink attached

Non Permanent Stand Alone Restrooms Restroom Trailers

- Advantages
 - More welcoming than Porta-John
 - Portable
 - Potential for a trial period
 - Can be heated
 - Can include sink
- Disadvantages
 - Poor aesthetics
 - Requires electrical hookup
 - Vandal proof options not readily available
 - Safety and vandalism concerns

Non Permanent Stand Alone Restrooms Men's Only Portable Facilities

- Advantages
 - Does not require attendant
 - Low maintenance
 - Portable
 - Economical
 - Uses minimal amount of space
- Disadvantages
 - Undesirable aesthetics
 - Men's Urination Only
 - Modesty, privacy concerns
 - Not comfortable in inclement weather
 - No sink attached

Embedded Facilities Lisa Link Peace Park Visitor Center

- Advantages
 - Existing infrastructure in downtown planning corridor
 - Accessible restroom
 - Aesthetics
 - Potential for a trial period
 - Heated
- Disadvantages
 - Requires staffing and modifications to deter crime and vandalism
 - May require modifications that reduce aesthetics of facility

Embedded Facilities Future Development Project

- Advantages
 - Potential to combine with other service/tourism facilities
 - Aesthetics
 - Comfortable in inclement weather
 - Customizable
 - Potential to bring additional visitors/customers to other facilities in building
- Disadvantages
 - Potential significant capital and operational cost
 - Not immediate solution
 - Requires agreement with potential developer
 - Requires utility infrastructure
 - Businesses may not want to participate
 - Potential disruption to other building patrons
