

- 1. CONTRACTOR SHALL KEEP ALL CITY STREETS FREE AND CLEAR OF
- 2. CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE A WATER TRUCK ON SITE DURING DEMOLITION AND WATER AREA AS NEEDED TO KEEP DUST DOWN.
- 4. ALL SAWCUTTING SHALL BE FULL DEPTH TO PROVIDE A CLEAN EDGE TO MATCH NEW CONSTRUCTION. MATCH EXISTING ELEVATIONS AT POINTS OF CONNECTION FOR NEW AND EXISTING PAVEMENT, CURB, SIDEWALKS, ETC. ALL SAWCUT LOCATIONS SHOWN ARE APPROXIMATE AND MAY BE FIELD ADJUSTED TO ACCOMMODATE CONDITIONS, JOINTS, MATERIAL TYPE, ETC. REMOVE MINIMUM AMOUNT NECESSARY FOR INSTALLATION
- 5. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY NECESSARY TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAGE AND SAFETY MEASURES DURING DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS WITHIN OR NEAR THE
- TO BE REMOVED SHALL BE REMOVED IN THEIR ENTIRETY AND STUMPS SHALL BE GROUND TO 12" BELOW PROPOSED SUBGRADE.
- CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS. MAINTAIN THROUGHOUT CONSTRUCTION.
- 8. CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN ANY NECESSARY DEMOLITION AND UTILITY
- THE CURB IN FRONT OF THE DRIVEWAYS AND RESTORING THE TERRACE
- REMOVED IN THEIR ENTIRETY, INCLUDING BASE AND ALL APPURTENANCES. COORDINATE ABANDONMENT OF ELECTRICAL LINES WITH ELECTRICAL ENGINEER AND OWNER PRIOR TO DEMOLITION.
- FROM CURB REPLACEMENT, WILL REQUIRE RESTORATION IN ACCORDANCE
- 1. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED DURING
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT SHOP DRAWINGS FOR REVIEW BY THE ENGINEER, PRIOR TO PLACING AN ORDER OF ANY SUCH ITEM.
- 3. EXISTING TOPOGRAPHIC INFORMATION IS BASED ON FIELD OBSERVATIONS AND/OR PLAN OF RECORD DRAWINGS. CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY TOPOGRAPHIC INFORMATION PRIOR TO STARTING CONSTRUCTION.
- 4. RIGHT OF WAY (ROW) AND PROPERTY LINES ARE APPROXIMATE. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROTECTING EXISTING PROPERTY CORNER MONUMENTATION. ANY MONUMENTS DISTURBED BY CONTRACTOR
- CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH DRY UTILITY COMPANY'S REGARDING ANY POTENTIAL CONFLICTS AND COORDINATE RELOCATIONS AS MAY BE REQUIRED. CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO COORDINATE THE PROPOSED
