- Add additional plant screening on west side of property, using smaller scale trees in combination with shade trees to provide canopy support to the roof deck. Consideration should be given to replacement of Maple trees with Muscle Wood and Quaking Aspen with Honeylocust, or similar plant typologies
- Change the guardrail on the west side of the roof deck to a more solid design for more effective screening
