

Arbor Hills- Leopold Neighborhood Plan

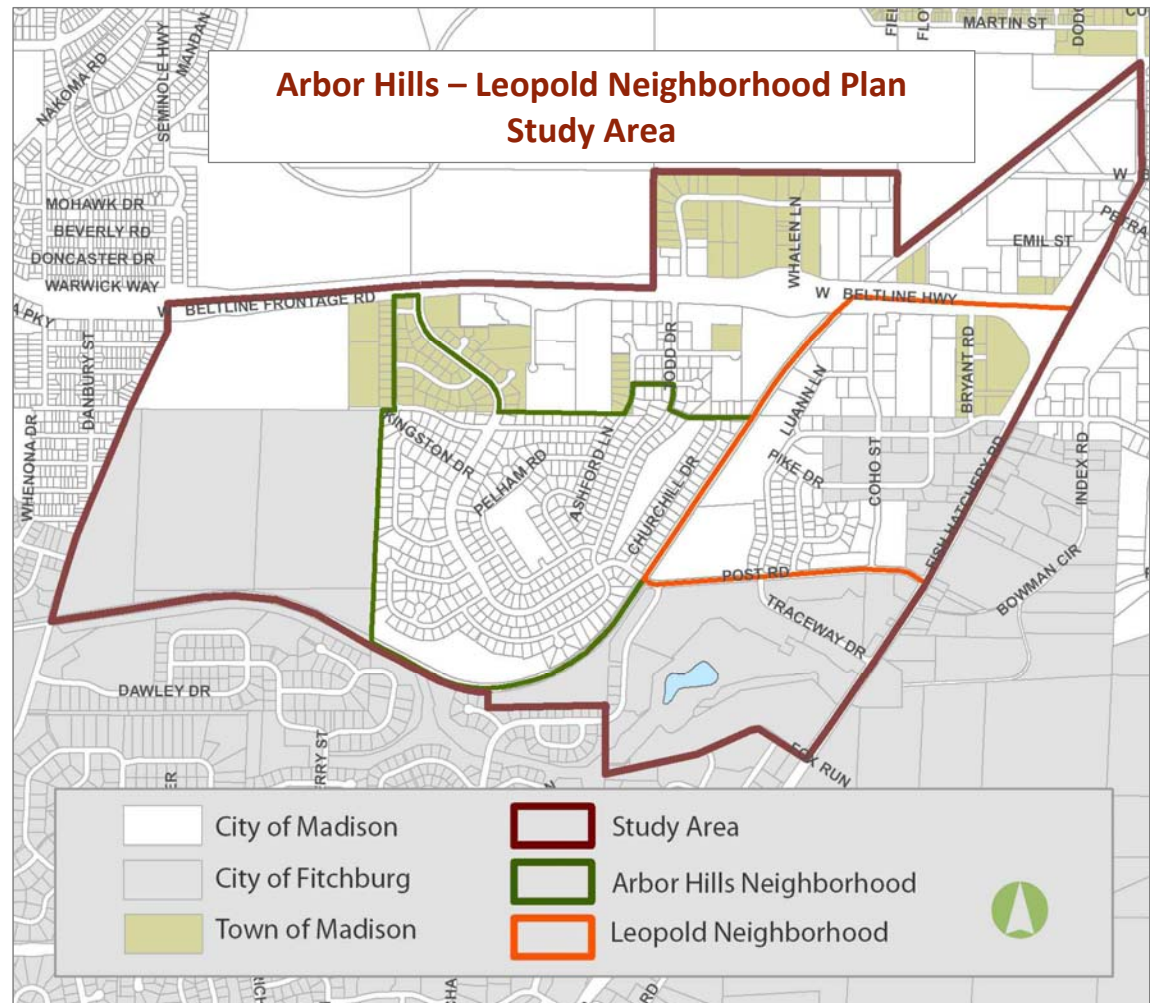
Plan Description and Purpose The City of Madison works with neighborhoods throughout the community to prepare neighborhood plans. The Arbor Hills-Leopold Neighborhood Plan (study area on the adjacent map) will be an advisory document for policymakers, municipal agencies, community groups and others who will initiate, direct, and manage decisions over the next 10 years concerning land use, housing, transportation, economic development, community services, and parks and open space improvements. It will include an existing conditions profile, neighborhood assets and issues, recommendations, and an implementation plan. The implementation plan will include the lead organizations and action steps necessary to realize the plan's goals and recommendations.

Project Team The City of Madison Planning Division will lead the planning process. Linda Horvath will be the Project Leader. A Project Team will coordinate planning efforts with the City of Fitchburg, Town of Madison and the Madison Metropolitan School District.

Stakeholder Outreach Elected officials, city staff, business owners, neighborhood leaders, and other stakeholders will meet periodically to identify issues, discuss strategies, problem solve, and review and comment on plan drafts.

General Planning Process Timeline The planning process will begin in May 2011 and continue until plan adoption in Winter or Spring of 2012.

Public Involvement The Project Team will integrally involve the public in preparing the neighborhood plan. There will be three Open Houses at key points in the process: 1) Neighborhood Plan Kick-Off; 2) Review and Comment: Goals, Objectives, and Preliminary Strategies; and 3) Review and Comment: Final Draft Plan. The Project Team will also interview stakeholders throughout the planning area. Spanish translation will be available.



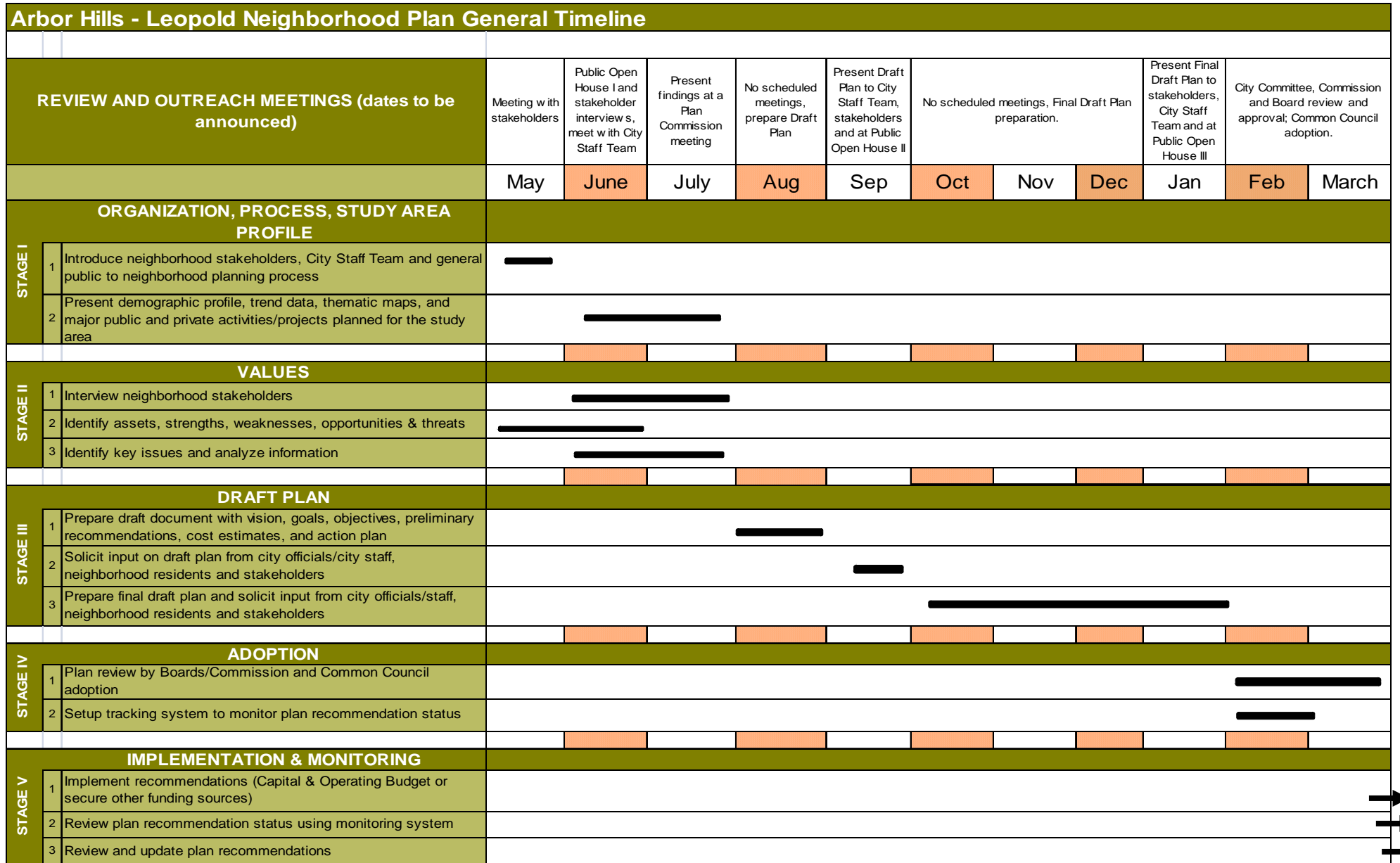
