On Wednesday, October 24, 2007, you appeared before the City of Madison Housing Committee and presented three complaints: Conditions at the Jail, Mold at the Hill Farms State Office Building (DOT), and your alleged unfair treatment by a landlord.

As the Housing Committee is a policy advisory body and not a regulatory one, we cannot take direct, specific action on any of those items. Nonetheless, we will forward your concerns about the jail and state office building to the appropriate facility managers, and, in addition, will forward the landlord item to our Landlord & Tenant Issues SEubcommittee for their attention as they consider any structural changes to the City's ordinances.
