## **Narrative Description of Options:**

Option A: Distribution as indicated by nominal group process

Option B: No Program Area loses more than 2%. Using Nominal Group Process as guide, Program areas are decreased by 2% and Adult Workforce receives more to get them closer to nominal group results.

Option C: No Program Area can lose or gain more than 2%. Using Nominal Group Process as guide, Program areas are decreased or increased in direction indicated. Workforce is allocated more to bring it in line with 7% floor and intent of nominal process.

Option D: No Program Area can lose or gain more than 3%. 3% Remains to allocate.
