Priorities for 2013

In addition to managing the ongoing business of the Housing Authority and Redevelopment Authority which includes administration of significant HUD grants, oversight of properties owned/controlled by the CDA and administration of various City of Madison housing and redevelopment programs, the CDA's priorities for 2013 are:

1. Village on Park:

- Complete sale of land to Access Community Health
- Complete Phase II demolition and site work
- Complete landlord work for Lanes Bakery
- Create a viable plan for asbestos remediation in the Atrium
- Negotiate extension of Space Place Lease

2. Truax Park Redevelopment:

- Apply for Low Income Housing Tax Credits for the new construction of 48 apartments to be operated as public housing
- Create a vision and viable financing plan for the construction of approximately 100 units of additional housing to serve a wider range of incomes. *Confirm Master Plan.*

3. Mosaic Ridge:

- Complete outreach in the Allied Drive Neighborhood
- Obtain land use and other public approvals

- Sign first contracts for the construction of single family homes
- Start 12 month Home Buyer Education and Readiness program for interested participants

4. Strategic Plan:

- Complete Strategic Planning with the CDA Board

5. Lake Point/Hoboken Redevelopment Plan

- Work with Office of Real Estate Services, the Planning Department and the Community Development Division to create a Redevelopment Plan for the corner of Lake Point and Hoboken.

6. Greenbush/Vilas

- Assist Economic Development Division with the creation and implementation of a program to promote improvement to the housing stock (particularly single family homes) in the Greenbush neighborhood

7. Combat Homelessness

- Assist the Community Development Division in creation of housing that would serve people that are homeless or at high risk of being homeless.
