RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Community Development Authority (CDA), through its 5-Year Annual Plan, intends to promote self-sufficiency and economic opportunities for Public Housing residents; and

WHEREAS, since 2012, the CDA has continually participated in the Resident Opportunities and Self Sufficiency (ROSS) Grant Program as provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, the ROSS grant provides three (3) year funding for case management services serving the CDA's West, East, Truax Phase 1, and Truax Phase 2 residents to achieve goals of employment, financial literacy, and digital literacy; and

WHEREAS, the CDA relies on the funds provided by the ROSS program to provide long-term financial support of a Service Coordinator position for the case management services; and

WHEREAS, the CDA's current ROSS grant will expire March 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the CDA wishes to continue to participate in the ROSS program for the long-term benefit of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the CDA has received fund matching commitments from community partners in the amount of \$72,345 to continue ROSS program specific goals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the CDA hereby authorizes the CDA Finance & Grants Manager, who is the HUD Authorized Organization Representative (AOR), as the designated signer of the 2022 ROSS grant application submission through HUD's online system; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CDA is authorized to accept a 2022 three year grant award in the amount of \$245,850 upon grant application approval by HUD.
