

Safety and Security Plan:

We retain both public (off-duty officers) and private security staff. At all times a minimum combined 4 uniformed security staffs are on-site. In addition, our the AtwoodFest committee consists of over 20 community members and most are experienced with previous events. Most security matters are addressed by these community members. Finally, an ETM is on-site at all times.

Notification Schedule:
