The developer, Simply Homes Madison LLC, has proposed to construct the final phase of right of way improvements for the plat known as Jannah Village. The developer shall build all street and public utility improvements to serve Lots 13-33 and 37-43. Standard City of Madison street improvements shall take place on all streets within this final phase. In this phase, the centerline of Canter Drive and Bridle Way also serves as the municipality boundary for the City of Madison and the Town of Burke. The Town of Burke is schedule to come into the City of Madison in 2036. The developer shall be responsible for the construction of these streets within the City of Madison boundary. Therefore, Canton Drive of this phase will be a one-way street northbound to serve the development. Any work taking place in Town of Burke right of way, will require the developer to obtain a permit from the Town of Burke. The developer shall also be responsible for street lights and terrace trees as required by the appropriate departments.

Madison Interstate East, LLC, the developer of private development project 3030 Ohmeda Drive CSM is required to construct public sanitary sewer along Femrite Drive from Meier Road to the west to serve the development project. The original plan consisted of CSM 15956 which included 3 lots and an outlot. A sanitary lateral from the main being constructed by the developer would serve Lot 1 of this CSM. Lots 2 and 3 of CSM 15956 would be served from a sanitary main on Omeda Drive running north of Femrite Drive constructed with City Public Works Project 13810. In 2023, the developer divided the land again with CSM 16276 making one lot from existing Lots 2 and 3 from CSM 15956. Lot 1 can now be served from the new sewer main on Femrite Drive and no longer needs to be

served by sanitary sewer to be constructed on Ohmeda Drive.

The City of Madison is pursuing a new public and private development opportunity that includes the demolition and replacement of the existing State Street Campus Garage (SSCG) at 415 North Lake Street. The building project will be completed in two construction phases. Phase 1 –the Public Works project- includes demolition of the existing SSCG and new construction will include an intercity bus terminal, public parking structure, and "gray box" spaces for final build out by private Developer. Phase 2 –constructed by the Developer and not included with this resolution- will include housing components built on top and within the Phase 1 construction. The estimated cost of the construction project is \$55,600,000.00.
