The Developer, BSH Storage Madison LLC, has received conditional approval for an indoor storage facility with approximately 700 units in a building consisting of a basement level and three stories, at 2503 Seiferth Road. The Developer shall be responsible for new sidewalk adjacent to the property on Seiferth Road and Pflaum Road, private sanitary, storm, and water lateral connections to serve the development, connection into the public storm sewer on Pflaum Road which will require a new inlet, approximately 75-feet of pipe and the connection into an existing inlet structure. The Developer shall protect all existing public terrace trees and planting of new trees along Pflaum Road and Seiferth Road at the completion of the project.
