18.	<u>08957</u>	Authorizing the provision of HOME/Match funds to assist Housing Initiatives with a rental housing project in ways that address City Community and Neighborhood Development Objectives.
19.	08820	Creating new Section 12.1335(4)(d), renumbering current Section 12.1335(4)(d) to Section 12.1335(4)(e), amending Section 12.1339, amending Section 12.141(2), creating new Section 12.141(3), renumbering current Sections 12.141(3)-(9) to Sections 12.141(4)-(10), and amending Section 1.08(3)(a) of the Madison General Ordinances to further deter snow parking violations and more efficiently allow for cleaning of the streets.
