ITEMS TO BE CONSIDERED

- 1. <u>07302</u> Amending the 2008 Parks Division Capital budget to increase the appropriation for tennis court repair and renovation by \$5,432 and to annually accept donations from the adult tennis league teams for that purpose.
- 2. 09565 Designating the Wisconsin State Journal as the official newspaper of the City of Madison.
- **3.** <u>08905</u> Approving the selection and purchase of Morning Pride firefighter safety gear from Jefferson Fire & Safety.

- 4. <u>09529</u> Approving the Fire Department to conduct Reading Rocks fund raising program to purchase rocking chairs from Ayers Furniture for elementary schools with reading corners.
- 5. 09548 Authorizing the Mayor, City Clerk and Chief of Police to accept a Targeting Violent Crimes Justice Assistance Grant from the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs in the amount of \$330,000 and to utilize these funds to develop and manage a violent career criminal intelligence system.
- 6. 09551 Authorizing the Mayor, City Clerk and Chief of Police to accept an award of thermal viewing equipment through the Department of Homeland Security's Commercial Equipment Direct Assistance Program (CEDAP).
- 7. 09338 Approving the transfer of \$25,000 from the Contingent Reserve to the State of Wisconsin for the purpose of studying the future of many of the coal-fired heat and power plants in Madison in partnership with the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration, the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and Dane County.

- 8. <u>09490</u> Amending the 2008 Fleet Service Capital Budget for coverage from the insurance fund for the replacement of a refuse truck destroyed by a fire.
- 9. 09546 Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk, as the operator of publicly owned transit services (Transit Operator), to enter into an agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) and the Madison Area Transportation Planning Board [A Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)] for continuing transportation planning for the Madison Metropolitan Area.
- **10.** <u>09547</u> Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an agreement with the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission (CARPC) for the Madison Area Transportation Planning Board (TPB) to provide transportation planning work activities to the CARPC in calendar year 2008 and amending the 2008 adopted operating budget of the Planning Division to recognize additional revenues of \$25,000.

Broom Street to convert it from a rental to owner-occupied housing.
