8.	<u>10543</u>	Re-authorizing the Madison Arts Commission to issue a request for proposals for the purpose of enlisting the services of a cultural planning consultant to assist the Madison Arts Commission in developing of a Cultural Plan for the City of Madison.
9.	<u>10431</u>	Approving Facade Improvement Grant to: 2701 Atwood Avenue (Africana Restaurant and Lounge).
10.	<u>09945</u>	Authorizing the provision of Community Development funds to assist Porchlight develop a "Housing First" model for families in ways that address City Community and Neighborhood Development Objectives.
