7.	11099	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a short-term lease with Hovde Building LLC for the use of the commercial office space located at 125 West Mifflin Street for a storefront project office for the Downtown Plan, and amending the 2008 Adopted PCED Capital Budget, Project #30, "Downtown Plan," project narrative to allow for \$18,000 in expenditures for an office space lease, including utilities (if the lease is extended to include the optional three months) and funding for additional facility/room rental and general office supplies. The Plan Commission is scheduled to consider this item on July 7.

10.	10682	Authorizing the City to enter into an agreement to accept funds from Dane County to continue the Pedestrian-Bicycle Coordinator Program in the Traffic Engineering Division.
11.	<u>11074</u>	Amending the Facilities Management and the Streets Division Capital Budgets by reducing the Facilities Management Capital Budget by \$75,000 and transfering this borrowing to the Street Division Capital Budget to fund improvements to Sycamore and Badger Street Facilities.
12.	10722	Accepting revised easement and transferring funds to reflect increased payment for easement and payment of special assessment on behalf of Dane County.

13.	<u>10984</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an agreement to fund a \$20,000 Daycare Center Rehabilitation Loan to Tenney Nursery and Parent Center, Inc. to fund the renovation of 1321 E. Mifflin Street.
14.	<u>11076</u>	SUBSTITUTE - Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a loan agreement to fund not to exceed \$47,204 Bassett Neighborhood Small Cap TIF Loan to Scott and Megin McDonell ("Borrower") to purchase and rehabilitate the property located at 404 W. Doty Street to convert it from a rental to owner-occupied housing.
