[16060](#) Terminating Fire Fighters Local 311 Post-Retirement Benefits Trust, authorizing the transfer of assets to a new Trust to be operated by the Precision Retirement Group, Inc., and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into agreements as may be necessary for such termination and transfer, including any necessary changes to the collective bargaining agreement between the City and Local 311.
