- 1. Amending Section 3.54(1)(b) of the Madison General Ordinances by deleting the classification of "Engineering Financial Officer" in Compensation Group 18, Range 10 and creating the classification of "Engineering Financial Manager" in Compensation Group 18, Range 12, thereof.
- 2. Recreating the Engineering Financial Officer position (18-10) in Engineering as an Engineering Financial Manager (18-12), and reallocating the incumbent to the new position.

3.	<u>15749</u>	Reclassifying the existing position of Personnel Technician 2 (#859) in HR as an HR Analyst 1, and reallocating the incumbent to the new classification and pay range.
4.	<u>15756</u>	Reclassifying the existing position of Program Assistant 2 (#868) in HR as an Administrative Assistant, and reallocating the incumbent to the new classification and pay range.
5.	<u>15757</u>	Recreating an Administrative Clerk 1 position (#2545) in Police as a Program Assistant 1 and reallocating the incumbent to the new position.
6.	<u>15782</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Labor Agreement between the City of Madison and the International Association of Firefighters, Local 311, for the period of January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011.
7.	<u>15437</u>	Accepting a 20-foot wide Public Water Main Easement within the Cannonball Path from the City of Fitchburg.
8.	<u>15547</u>	Authorizing the execution of a Declaration of Public Water Main Easement pertaining to the City-owned Cannonball Run Bike Path Corridor.
9.	<u>15882</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Dane County Human Services to provide Retired Senior Volunteer Driver Escort Services for the City of Madison for the calendar year 2009.
10.	<u>15883</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to accept sponsorship by MillerCoors, LLC in the amount of \$10,000 to help offset the cost of providing free expanded transit service on New Year's Eve. The agreement includes an indemnification clause.
11.	<u>15909</u>	Approval to accept a Homeland Security Metropolitan Medical Response System 2008 grant for \$321,221.
12.	<u>15760</u>	Amending the 2009 Fire Department Capital Budget by \$45,720.73 for the roof replacement at Station No.7 at 1810 McKenna Blvd. that is covered by the insurance fund.
13.	<u>15776</u>	Authorizing the creation of a pilot Downtown Residential Exterior Lighting Enhancement Grant Program to provide one-time matching grants to residential property owners in targeted areas to enhance the exterior lighting around their properties.
14.	<u>15778</u>	SUBSTITUTE Authorizing the use of non-standard indemnification language in an Easement for Public Pedestrian and Bicycle Path purposes between the City and University Research Park, Incorporated.
15.	<u>15790</u>	Approving the extension of a Section 17 loan to The Young Women's Christian Association of Madison, Wisconsin, Inc. and the assignment and assumption of various loan obligations thereunder to YWCA Madison Housing, LLC; authorizing the City's forgiveness of interest; and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute all documents as may be necessary to conclude this transaction.

16.	<u>15787</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the Third Addendum to Agreement between the City of Madison and Dane County for the Sale of Space in the City-County Building.
17.	<u>15282</u>	Adopting the Northport-Warner Park-Sherman Neighborhood Plan as a supplement to the City of Madison Comprehensive Plan.
18.	<u>15708</u>	Approve the authorization of a long-term deferred loan to Madison Association of the Deaf, Inc. (M.A.D.) for up to \$32,000 in CDBG funds to make accessibility, safety and energy efficiency improvements at their facility at 1109 Williamson St.
19.	<u>15710</u>	"SUBSTITUTE - "Authorizing the provision of an additional \$108,000 in Federal HOME funds to assist Housing Initiatives, Inc. to acquire and rehabilitate rental housing.
20.	<u>15772</u>	Authorizing a loan of HOME funds to Future Madison Northpointe, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$225,000, and authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute any required agreements with Future Madison Northpointe.
21.	<u>15807</u>	Authorizing the use of Federal HOME funds in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 to provide additional down payment assistance to qualified homebuyers as part of the City's American Dream Down payment (ADDI) program, and authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute any associated agreements as required.
22.	<u>15967</u>	Approve the request from Independent Living, Inc. to provide up to \$56,578 in Home Match and CDBG funds to make needed repairs to their rental housing facility at 602 N. Segoe Rd., to improve the building's energy efficiency, safety and accessibility, and protection from water leakage and damage to the building.
23.	<u>15805</u>	Establishing a voluntary rifle purchase program that would allow commissioned employees to voluntarily purchase department-approved rifles for on-duty use, utilize the department's bulk purchasing power to order the rifles, and establish a two (2) year repayment mechanism by which the cost of the rifle would be recovered through fifty-two (52) equal deductions taken from the employee's paycheck.
24.	<u>15843</u>	Amending the 2009 Operating Budgets of the Police Department, Engineering Division, Streets Division and Parks Division by appropriating \$48,335 from the Contingent Reserve Fund, utilizing these funds for various expenses related to the Halloween event, and authorizing the receipt of revenues derived from admission fees and donations.
25.	<u>15845</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a contract with Frank Productions, Inc., subject to the conditions included in the Street Use Permit expected to be issued to Frank Productions, Inc. for events associated with Halloween, 2009.
26.	<u>15847</u>	Establishing a Glass-Free Zone for the State Street area from 9:30 p.m. on October 30, 2009 to 6:00 a.m. on October 31, 2009, and from 9:30 p.m. on October 31, 2009 to 6:00 a.m. on November 1, 2009.
