4.	<u>16391</u>	Creation of the Municipal Clerk series within CG 20 (Municipal Clerk 1-Range 9, Municipal Clerk 2-Range 10, Certified Municipal Clerk-Range 11), creation of three (3) positions of Certified Municipal Clerk in the Clerk's office budget, and reallocation of three Administrative Clerks 1 to the appropriate levels within the new series.
5.	<u>16436</u>	Adopting and confirming the Labor Agreement between the City of Madison and the Association of Madison Police Supervisors (AMPS) for the period January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2011.
6.	<u>16434</u>	Amending Secs 9.13(6)(h)3.a.i. and iii., Sec. 9.13(6)(h)3.b.i., Secs.9.13(6)(h)3.c.i. and ii. to increase the street vending license fees for mall/concourse food vendors, merchant vendors, and license and other fees for arts and crafts vendors; and amending Sec. 31.075(2)(a) of the Madison General Ordinances to increase the permit fee for promotional banners.
7.	<u>16369</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into agreements with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for the design and construction of STH 113 (First Street to Knutson Drive).
8.	<u>16444</u>	A resolution declaring the City of Madison an Energy Independent Community with the goal of procuring 25% of the City of Madison's (Operations) electricity and transportation fuels from renewable resources by 2025 and joining the Wisconsin Energy Independent Community Partnership.
9.	<u>16450</u>	SUBSTITUTE - Authorizing the City of Madison to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) in the amount of \$2,384,600 and to use these funds for energy efficiency and conservation activities, amending the 2009 CDBG Operating Budget, and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign appropriate agreements to accept the funds and implement the program.
10.	<u>16062</u>	SECOND SUBSTITUTE - Amending the 2009-2010 Community and Neighborhood Development Program Funding Framework to delete the shared appreciation requirement for non-profit agencies.
11.	<u>16264</u>	Authorizing the carry-over of CDBG, HOME and other funds, and the extension of previously authorized projects within the Community Development program budget.
12.	<u>16313</u>	Approve the provision of \$71,850 in CDBG funds to the Madison Metropolitan School District for space and operating costs at the Meadowood Neighborhood Center, 5734 Raymond Road.
13.	<u>16416</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and Chief of Police to accept four (4) traffic safety grants totaling \$73,000 from Wisconsin Department of Transportation for the following activities in 2009/2010: Alcohol Enforcement (\$35,000), Speed Enforcement (\$30,000), Pedestrian Safety Enforcement (\$4,000) and Bicycle Safety Enforcement (\$4,000).
