21.	<u>15867</u>	Creating Section 27.04(2)(I) of the Madison General Ordinances to require owners of multi-family dwellings to provide contact information of at least two people who can exercise control and care over the property; and amending Sec. 1.08(3)(a) to create a bail deposit for violations.
22.	<u>16950</u>	Authorizing an amendment to the contract between the City of Madison and Ken Saiki Designs, Inc., in the amount of \$62,300 for additional architectural and engineering design services for the Lisa Link Park Improvements project. The Board of Park Commissioners is scheduled to consider this item on 1-13-2010.
23.	<u>17009</u>	Authorizing the execution of a Purchase Agreement with the Natural Heritage Land Trust, Inc. for the City's acquisition of lands for the expansion of the Cherokee Marsh Conservation Park and amending the 2010 Parks Capital Budget to authorize the expenditure of funds for this acquisition. <i>The Plan Commission is scheduled to consider this item on 1-11-2010.</i> <i>The Board of Parks Commissioners is scheduled to consider this item on 1-13-2010.</i>

25.	<u>16902</u>	Authorizing the CDBG Office to submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), Transitional Housing Program (THP) and Homeless Prevention Program (HPP) funds on behalf of specific agencies providing housing and services for homeless persons.
26.	<u>16941</u>	Authorizing the subordination of previously approved loan to YWCA of Madison, Inc. to Forward Community Investments (FCI) and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign agreements to effect such subordination.
27.	<u>16942</u>	Authorizing the subordination of previously approved loans to Housing Initiatives, Inc. to Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority (WHEDA) and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign agreements to effect such a change.
