3.	<u>18243</u>	Determining a Public Purpose and Necessity and Adopting a Relocation Order for the acquisition of land interests located at 220 Merry Street, 230 Merry Street and 1626 Winnebago Street for the completion of the Yahara River Parkway and Pedestrian Path, and amending the 2010 Parks Division Capital Budget. The Pedestrian/Bicycle/Motor Vehicle Commission is scheduled to consider this item on May 25.
4.	<u>18269</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to amend the contracts with The Bower Group and Vandewalle & Associates/The Hiebing Group Inc. for consultation services to implement the East Washington Avenue Capitol Gateway Corridor Plan, and related projects within the Capitol East District, for an amount not to exceed \$201,000 total for a term of the agreement through December 31, 2010.
5.	<u>18498</u>	Repealing Sections 4.07(1) and (2) and creating Sections 4.07 (1) through (11) of the Madison General Ordinances to provide for installment payment of real property tax and personal property taxes for improvements on leased land and establish payment procedures for personal property tax, special charges, special assessments and special taxes.
6.	<u>18456</u>	Amending the Information Technology 2010 Capital Budget by transferring \$40,000 from Contingent Reserve to the Purchased Software Enhancements Project # 810345 to fund modifications to the City's Tax Billing and Collection Software to accommodate multiple tax payment installments.
7.	<u>18564</u>	Amending the 2010 Operating Budget of the Community Development Division by appropriating \$40,000 from the Contingent Reserve Fund and utilitizing these funds to contract with a variety of agencies focused on youth engagement in neighborhoods on the southwest side.
8.	<u>18139</u>	Update on the Status of the Overture Center.
