- 2. DISCUSSION ITEM: Discuss and evaluate Ordinance and Regulations language pertaining to uniformity in all street vending categories having seniority status based on their first day licensed. Two documents from Assistant City Attorney Lara Mainella, with the following titles, will be discussed:
  - A. An ordinance amending sections 9.13 (6)(n)4.b and 9.13(10)(g)2. of the Madison General Ordinances to revise the method of determining vendors' seniority.

    B. A resolution authorizing amendments to the "Regulations Governing Vending on the State Street Mall/Capitol Concourse" and "Regulations Governing Vending in High Density Vending Areas" to require consecutive years of licensed vending in determining seniority for certain types of vending licenses and site assignment procedures.
- 3. STREET VENDING COORDINATOR'S REPORT Which may include the status quo and numbers of vendors in different categories, enforcement efforts, preparation for football game day vending, forthcoming publications about American street food, the progress of the Street Vendor Monitor.
