RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

28. 22286

Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Pine Hill Plat Pond Construction, Contract No. 6710.

Estimated cost of this project is \$75,000. This project involves work required to complete the infiltration basin for the Pine Hill Farm Plat that was not completed by the developer. The overburden soils that were left in place during initial construction must be removed (approximately 1.5 to 2 feet) over the bottom of the infiltration basin and replaced with 8 inches of engineered soil. The basin bottom will then be seeded with City Standard infiltration seed mix and matted. Any disturbance resulting from access to the pond will also be restored. All costs incurred by this project for finishing the infiltration basin will be billed to the developer.

DISCUSSION AND RECOMMENDATION

Estimated cost of this project is \$350,000. The condition of the parking lot and pavement area for the Streets West Facilities located at 1501 West Badger Road is in constant need of repairs. The Parks Division has money in the 2011 budget for the purchase and installation of a pre-fabricated press box for the Breese Stevens Field Soccer Facility. This project has been broken down into 2 parts;

- 1. purchase/manufacture of a press box and
- 2. installation of the press box

The Parks Division is requesting permission to advertise and receive bids for part 2 - the installation of the press box. Plans and Specifications for the manufacture of the press box are presently out through the City Purchasing Division. Quotes are due May 13th. Information received from the approved manufacturer (footing design), will be put in Public Works Contract #6665 Breese Stevens Press Box Installation, the first ad being May 27th. This contract will include coordination of the delivery with the manufacturer, installation of the footings and base, receiving and offloading the press box and setting/securing it on the base. The final electrical connections will be done by Parks Division staff. Estimated cost of this project is \$60,000. Report by the Parks Division.

(asphalt, 12' fencing, net posts, nets, color, etc.), plus the asphalt pad for the remaining 4 courts. This contract includes the installation of 12' fencing, net posts, nets and color for the remaining 4 courts. Report by Parks Division.
