This project consists of repairs to the existing Lake Edge Basin, which failed during a storm event in 2010. The drainage area discharging to the basin is approximately 90% within the Corporate Limits of the City of Madison. The City has previously signed an intergovernmental agreement with Monona, and is responsible for 75% of the cost to repair the basin. Estimated cost of this project is \$70,000.
