Joe Daniels Construction has requested a contract extension through January 31, 2012 to complete Contract 6660 Madison Police Training Center Phase 1. Significant differences in the dimensions for Air Handling Unit #2 resulted in less than adequate maintenance circulation in the mechanical mezzanine and was identified in late October. The overall process to reach a satisfactory solution for this change order has been a four (4) week process. During this time the mezzanine build out was minimized and eventually had to be stopped. The extension will give the affected subcontractors sufficient time to complete the build out of the mechanical mezzanine and to conduct the final testing/balancing of the HVAC.
