- 1. <u>21489</u> Amending Section 3.54(1)(b) of the Madison General Ordinances by repealing the classification of "Parks Maintenance Manager" in Compensation Group 18, Range 14, and creating the classification of "Parks Operations Manager" in the same compensation group and range, thereof.
- 2. <u>21498</u> Retitle the classification of Parks Maintenance Manager, in CG18, Range 14 as a Parks Operations Manager, and recreate the vacant position (#1546) of Parks Maintenance Manager as a Parks Operations Manager in the Parks Division budget.

3.	<u>21397</u>	Authorizing the Mayor, City Clerk and Chief of Police to accept up to \$40,500 for cold case investigations using DNA analysis from a U.S. Department of Justice grant awarded to the Wisconsin Department of Justice, in cooperation with the Madison Police Department, the Dane County Sheriff's Office, the Dane County Coroner's Office and the Rock County Sheriff's Office.
4.	<u>21525</u>	Approving the 2011 Neighborhood Grant Program recommendations made by the Staff Review Team and authorizing the Planning Division Director, Comptroller and City Attorney to execute grant agreements on behalf of the City.
5.	<u>21368</u>	Amending Resolution 18929 to allow Common Wealth Development (CWD) to acquire and rehab 433 Cantwell Ct. instead of 434 S. Thornton Ave. Resolution 18929 authorized the provision of \$432,000 in Federal HOME Match funds to CWD to assist them acquiring and rehabilitating two 4 - unit buildings to provide affordable rental housing.
6.	<u>21369</u>	Authorizing the CD Division to submit an application to the state Bureau of Supportive Services for Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), Transitional Housing Program (THP) and Homeless Prevention Program (HPP) funds on behalf of specific agencies providing housing and services to homeless persons.
7.	<u>21357</u>	Amending the 2011 Capital Budget of Facilities Management to authorize the spending of additional rebate funding received from Focus on Energy.
8.	<u>21390</u>	Amending the 2011 Operating Budget of Engineering, Accepting a Grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to Execute the Grant Agreement and Related Grant Partner Contracts
9.	<u>21438</u>	Authorizing amendments to the land contracts entered into between the City of Madison and Hartmeyer LLC and Madison Ice MIA LLC for the purchase of the Hartmeyer and Madison Ice Arenas.
10.	<u>21515</u>	Authorizing the execution of a lease at 316 West Washington Avenue for the temporary relocation of the City of Madison's Central Public Library.
11.	<u>21435</u>	Authorizing a first amendment to the lease between the City of Madison and Yahara Square Associates, LLP within the East Rail Transportation Corridor. The Plan Commission is scheduled to consider this item on 3-7-2011.
12.	<u>21521</u>	Cancelling or reducing budget authorization totaling \$3,015,070 for certain projects authorized in the 2010 Capital Budget.
13.	<u>20850</u>	A second substitute resolution revising the Rate Adjustment Policy as Provided by Section 37.05(4)(d) of the Madison General Ordinances.
14.	<u>21254</u>	Approving and adopting a Policy for funding the Undergrounding of Overhead Utility Lines.

- **15.** <u>21454</u> Accepting the Development Process Initiative Report dated January 31, 2011 as amended and approved by the Economic Development Committee on February 16, 2011; and, directing the City Attorney and responsible department/division directors to begin immediate implementation of the recommendations contained therein, including the formulation of ordinance modifications and budget proposals where necessary.
