12.	<u>23628</u>	Amending RES 11-00538 (File ID 22622 and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an agreement to fund a Madison Capital Revolving Fund loan to TJ's Taylor's One Price Cleaners, Inc. to purchase machinery and equipment and renovate the property at 4522 Verona Road into 8,800 SF of commercial space.

CLOSED SESSION NOTICE

When the Board of Estimates considers the following item, it may go into closed session pursuant to 19.85(1)(g), Wisconsin Statutes, which reads as follows: Conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved. If the Board of Estimates does convene in closed session as described above, upon completion of the closed session, notice is hereby given that it may reconvene in open session to consider the following items without waiting 12 hours, pursuant to Wis. Stats. Sec. 19.85(2).

13. <u>22180</u> Authorizing the payment of a judgment in Adams Outdoor Advertising v. City of Madison 329 Wis. 2d 270, (Wis. App. 2010) Unpublished, and a settlement with Adams Outdoor Advertising: (1) payment of a judgment relating to a refund of property taxes for tax years 2002-2004 and 2006 which provides for a refund of taxes, interest and costs in the amount of \$710,467.00 from City resources and amending the 2011 operating budget to reduce estimated General Fund revenues by \$119,415.69 to recognize the City's share of the tax refund and appropriating \$368,770.47 from the Contingent Reserve to fund related interest and court costs; and (2) authorizing the payment of a settlement in Adams Outdoor Advertising v. City of Madison in tax years 2007-2010 for an additional refund of \$368,625.00 without interest and costs. The City's 2011 operating budget is amended to reduce the general fund revenues by \$135,407.59 to recognize the City's share of the settlement costs.
