- 2. <u>24875</u> Create a new 0.9 FTE position of Library Media Coordinator in the Library Budget to be posted and filled through an internal competitive process. Upon filling the position, the underlying vacancy will be deleted.
- **3. 24876** Recreate the 0.8 FTE position #3242 of Library Assistant 1 (CG32, R 05), currently occupied by J. Muzzall, as a 0.9 FTE Librarian 1 (CG33, R 01) within the Library Budget, and reallocate the incumbent to the new position.

6.	<u>24550</u>	Approving the double-fill of a Parking Operations Manager position due to the retirement of the current Parking Operations Manager, William Knobeloch.

8.	<u>24646</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Dane County to provide \$19,300 in assistance to Metro Transit for transit information services, promotion efforts, and operations for calendar year 2012, and \$5,000 to the Madison Area Transportation Planning Board (a Metropolitan Planning Organziation) to support the County Specialized Transportation coordination activities for the calendar year 2012.
9.	<u>24906</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute maintenance contracts as needed for Cisco hardware and software support and maintenance services.
10.	<u>24916</u>	Amending the Park Division's 2012 Operating Budget and authorizing the Parks Superintendent to apply for and enter into Partners for Fish and Wildlife Habitat Development Agreements with the United States Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service for in-kind supplies and materials to be utilized in City of Madison Parks. (Various ADs)

12.	<u>24912</u>	Approving the extension of the contract with the City for Fire Department Regional Hazardous Materials Response Team Services. The contract is with the State of Wisconsin, Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management.
13.	<u>24773</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and Chief of Police to accept vehicles and other equipment from the Wisconsin 1033 Program.
14.	<u>24889</u>	Police Department Report: CARD Project Workplan

18.	<u>24910</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to amend the contracts with The Bower Group and Vandewalle & Associates / The Hiebing Group Inc. for consultation services to implement the East Washington Avenue Capitol Gateway Corridor Plan and related projects within the Capitol East District, for an amount not to exceed \$175,000 total for a term of the agreement through December 31, 2012.
19.	<u>24651</u>	SUBSTITUTE Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a development agreement to fund a \$1,898,000 Tax Incremental Finance Loan to 1102 South Park Street, LLC to assist in the development of the Wingra Clinic commercial redevelopment project located at 1102 South Park Street on a portion of the former Bancroft Dairy in the proposed TID #42 (Wingra).
