1.	<u>25182</u>	Create a new 1.0 FTE position of Architect 3-LTE in the Engineering Division budget to be posted and filled through an internal competitive process. Upon filling the position, the Architect 2 LTE (pos. #4309) assignment in the Engineering Division will be ended.
2.	25216	Amending the 2012 Adopted Operating Budgets of the Community Development

- 2. 25216 Amending the 2012 Adopted Operating Budgets of the Community Development Division and the Finance Department to transfer a 1.0 FTE Grant Writer position and associated salary and benefit expense from CDD to Finance.
- 3. 25109 Amending the 2012 Operating Budgets for Engineering, Sewer Utility, Stormwater Utility and Landfill for the reassignment of 2 positions and the creation of 1 position, and Appropriating \$6,212 from the Contingent Reserve.

4.	<u>25142</u>	Authorizing the Madison Police Department to contract with LeadsOnline to provide access to an electronic database of sales and purchases from secondhand dealers, and amending the 2012 Operating Budget for the associated revenues and expenditures and the addition of one new position.
5.	<u>25241</u>	Amending the 2012 Public Health Operating Budget to allow for the carryforward of two grants from 2011.
6.	<u>25198</u>	A resolution required by the Department of Workforce Development for the reauthorizing of the City of Madison's Self-Insured Worker's Compensation Program.
7.	<u>25256</u>	Amending Sec. 38.05(3)(c), creating Sec. 38.05(3)(f)3., amending Secs. 38.06(11)(k) and (12)(e) of the Madison General Ordinances to increase noticing fees and entertainment licenses fees.
8.	<u>25174</u>	Canceling or reducing budget authorization totaling \$23,541,858 for certain projects authorized in the 2011 Capital Budget.
9.	<u>25223</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an Agreement with Madison Fireworks Fund, Inc. to provide the 2012 Rhythm & Booms Independence Day firework celebration at Warner Park.
10.	<u>25394</u>	Authorizing the City Treasurer to notify the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration to distribute amounts determined for the school levy tax credit and the lottery and gaming credit for the City of Madison directly to the City Treasurer.  This item was introduced directly to the Board of Estimates and not referred by the Common Council.
11.	<u>25022</u>	Amending the 2012 Public Health and Engineering Operating Budget to appropriate \$25,000 for a study to establish a baseline level of contamination for sediment, soil, vegetation and water at Warner Park and the Lagoons.  This item was inadvertently not referred to the Board of Estimates.
12.	<u>25053</u>	Accepting a proposal from Dawn O'Kroley for the purchase of the residential structure located at 646 East Gorham Street within James Madison Park and authorizing staff to negotiate final terms for the purchase of the residential structure and a lease of the land beneath it.
13.	<u>25056</u>	Accepting a Selection Committee's recommendation of The Rifken Group, LTD proposal for the purchase and redevelopment of City-owned properties in the 800 Block of East Washington Avenue and authorizing the execution of a Purchase and Sale Agreement with The Rifken Group, LTD and Irgens Development Partners, LLC for the purchase and redevelopment of these properties.
14.	<u>25246</u>	Authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning & Community & Economic Development to issue a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for consultant services to hire a private-sector work team to partner with City staff on the preparation of a Madison Sustainability Commerce Center Feasibility Study ("Study"), and authorizing a City staff team to select the work team consultant(s) to prepare said Study.

15.	24468	A Resolution Adopting the Downtown Plan as a Supplement to the City of Madison Comprehensive Plan.
16.	<u>24778</u>	SUBSTITUTE Creating Sections 39.07 and 33.07(7)(k)13. of the Madison General Ordinances to require contractors to provide benefits to employees with domestic partners that are equal to the benefits offered and provided to married employees.
